ADMISSION OF THE AZERBAIJAN REPUBLIC TO MEMBERSHIP IN THE UNITED NATIONS

The General Assembly:

Having received the recommendation of the Security Council of 14 February 1992 that the Azerbaijani Republic should be admitted to membership in the United Nations (document A/46/880 above).

Having considered the application for membership of the Azerbaijani Republic (document A/46/872-S/23558 above).

Decides to admit the Azerbaijani Republic to membership in the United Nations.



The Statement of the Chairman of the Security Council

In the 3052nd session of the Security Council on February 14, 1992, the Chairman of the Security Council made the following statement on behalf of its members connected with the consideration of the issue "On the admission of new members".

"The Security Council has just recommended the Republic of Azerbaijan to be admitted in the membership of the United Nations. It is a great pleasure to me to congratulate the Republic of Azerbaijan on the occasion of this historical event on behalf of the members of the Security Council. We think that only in this way one may gain the further strengthening of the principle of universality.

The members of the Security Council noted with great satisfaction that Azerbaijan solemnly undertook the obligation to adhere to the goals and principle of the Charter of the United Nations, including the peaceful solution of differences and inadmissibility of violence. All the members of the Security Council are impatiently waiting for the day when Azerbaijan will join us in the capacity of the member of the United Nations. We are waiting for the meeting with the representatives of Azerbaijan and we hope to work with them in close cooperation".

ACTION TAKEN BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

At its 82nd plenary meeting, on 2 March 1992, the General Assembly adopted the following draft resolution:

A/47/L.65 and Add.1 concerning the admission of the Azerbaijani Republic to membership in the United Nations.
