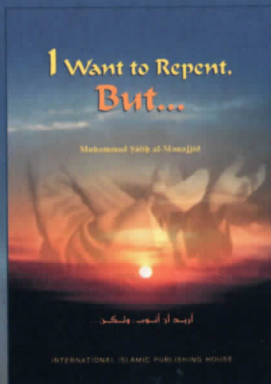


I Want to Repent, But...
