.....CONSTITUTIONAL FREEDOM

The constitution entrusts the police force with security, law enforcement, power of detention. MACC does not exist when constitution written and is not envisaged to hold such powers.

The High Court judge is right, the constitution should not allow too many bodies power over civil liberties. Similarly the constitution does not grant prosecution powers to other bodies except Attorney General.

The judge is looking at civil liberty and freedom. Detention without trial or charge (24hrs interrogation) is violation of basic freedoms and should not be granted freely.

.....ROLE OF MACC

MACC is a post crime investigation agency, not pre crime prevention body. With investigative not security or preventive powers (from its actions so far) there is no need to give this agency 24hrs detention authority without charge or trial.

Power of detention should be given to only security and safety agencies, not agencies investigating political parties, councilors purchase of stationery etc.

.....CIVIL RIGHTS ABUSE

It will lead to civil rights abuse which such powers over civil liberties is prone. Already the police (one agency granted such powers) sometimes act out of control.

Since the crime already committed and no security risk involved why need 24hr powers? Anyway if MACC require such power they can refer police.

.....REDUCING CRIME

Giving MACC 24 hrs detention powers will not reduce crime, as it only acts after the crime has taken place. But dissolving Umno is guaranteed to reduce crime by 900 cases (Tun's quote on Umno corruption reports)

AN OPTION FOR AN HONEST JUDGE

It is interwsting to see how a simple posting by Tun has provoked such a vibrant discussion! I see that there are some who are genuinely concerned about the vesting of such powers of questioning to the MACC.

However let us not lose sight of the real issue and what an honest judge should have done. The issue is what does the words "day-to-day" mean ? It surely does not have a time limitation in it. It certainly means one day to the next. And yes- it does encompass 24 hours and midnight. Whether we agree or disagree in terms of what the law SHOULD BE, the fact of the matter is that, this is what the law is. That said what is the judge's duty. It is not for him to reform legislation, that is a matter for Parliament, it is for him to interpret and apply the law, irrespective of whether he likes the law or not.

An honest judge would have been compelled to hold that "day-to-day" did not have such a limitation upon its construction.

But his powers do not stop there, having given an honest pronouncement of what the law provides he could do the following:

1. express in candid terms the problems posed by this legislation and the need to introduce safeguards. The legislature can then examine this critically and decide what safeguards to impose;
2. he may examine whether despite having the power to question people as such, the MACC had acted reasonably in the exercise of those powers in this case. Under Malaysian law, all powers are subject to implicit limits. They must be reasonably exercised, the authority must have regard for relevant matters and disregard irrelevant matters and where a person's liberty is at stake, the exercise of these powers would have been subjected to a more rigorous examination.

The Judge could have examined the circumstances of this case- the subject matter involved, its value, the lack of urgency, the fact that the accused was not a flight risk and to have then held that the exercise of the power to question a person from "day-to-day" was done unreasonably.

In this way the meaning of the law would not have been distorted and the Judge's intervention would have been, apt, judicious and proper.

This is why sobriety, honesty and moderation are so important qualities for a Judge to have. It is important that they do not impose their personal beliefs upon the sacred task of statutory interpretation. Today people cheer these judges, what if we have judges tomorrow who decide to import words of a different nature into other legislation, what if the words which they import do not accord with the general conscience of the country.

I would have expected many lawyers to speak up against this kind of judicial activism where an un-elected judiciary seeks to influence legislative policy under the guise of statutory interpretation.

Now it seems, people could not stretch their workload for overtime. The government could save money on wages and in return, buy executive jet, like Dollah did.

But I do not agree that bus company should operates, only daytime, just because somebody falls to sleep on the job. Many people ride buses during the night, so they can sleep on it, then go to work, somewhere far away, the next day.

Sleeping on the job, no matter what livelihood it may be, especially when the lives of many is in your hands, is serious an offence, as in the military.

The way people sleep or falls to sleep, is just different. Some people sleep 'dead' while others would be awoken with a slightest squeak of the door. Falling to sleep does not necessarily be at night. I know of a man who falls to sleep, riding a motorcycle, after work at 1700H and he is not high on drugs or alcohol. Since he was riding on motorcycle lane, nobody was injured, except himself.

It is good to have a 2nd. bus driver, but we all know the off-duty driver will go to sleep as soon as he can. I have never agree with the idea of 'short nap'. To me a short nap, during the day or night, especially doing it not on a comfortable bed or place, would make me more sleepy.


Therefore, I suggest:-

1. Both drivers are not permitted to sleep, at any time, day or night, when the bus is moving. The off-duty driver is responsible, to make sure that his driving partner is fully awake or conscious. I have heard of a few people, having a heart attack, while driving.
2. Place a live camera on the face of the driver, so that passengers can monitor the driver's alertness. (Some people just couldn't sleep, riding a bus.) Best still, if it can be monitored by HQ. Some kind of alarm or fixture, fixed near the drivers can be activated.
3. If there is some sort of 'Sleep Behaviour Study', bus driver should be assessed on how easily one falls to sleep.
4. People who have more than 1 wife should not be driving a bus at night, especially when they already have many children. People with additional wife, usually is quite sleepy, most of the time.
5. People who to gambles a lot, should not be a bus driver.

I have many times, usually during weekends, from KL, drive my family back to Kuala Ketil, night to dawn. Just before sunrise, is the sleepest moment. When the sky becomes bright, I feel fresh as ever. 0800H breakfast with my parents. At noon, off to Kubur Panjang, my wife's hometown. By 2000H, I was already asleep.

On one occasion, I try drinking 'air ketum', thinking it might make me go to sleep faster. I was wrong. I can only fall asleep at 0400H, although I have not slept the previous night. There was no 'high' feeling at all. Sireh leaf with beetle nut is much stronger, I think. No wonder, long distance lorry driver like it very much. I heard it is undetectable by Urine test. It's not additive. I really don't understand why the authorities classify 'Daun Ketum' as dangerous. I would be glad if somebody could explain.

Dear Tun,

The Bar Council and by its propaganda, certain members of the public have become mesmerized with certain flawed decisions of the High Court. These decisions are erroneous in law. Far from disclosing a trend towards legal integrity it seems to disclose instead a desire by certain judges to come out with decisions which are grounded not on law but on their desire to seek populist approval.

In fact it has crossed my mind that some of these judges are probably hedging their bets following the March 2008 elections. Let us consider some of these instances:

1. the High Court made a declaration in favour of Dato Nizar. The declaration had the effect of reinstating him into office, despite the fact that at the time the declaration was given, Nizar ceased to have majority in the Assembly. He did not have the qualifications to become an MB under the law, yet this is what the High Court decision did for him.

We are told in glowing terms about the famous 70 over page decision of the High Court judge. I would invite people to look at that document and then tell me how much of it was scholarship and how much was a cut and past job of copying passage upon passage from the documents filed in Court.

But the question must be asked – how could such a declaration be made for a person who did not qualify to remain in office. The question must be asked – why didn't the High Court Judge pay any attention to the fact that Nizar and his team led by Sivakumar had deliberately suspended many BN Assemblymen, in defiance of the sub-judice rule in order to tilt the position of the assembly.

Why didn't the Bar Council and others speak up against the way in which Zamry and others were suspended by the Speaker on a flimsy charge that they had wrongfully held themselves out as MB and EXCO members? This very issue was being challenged in the High Court, how could Sivakumar issue a showcause and arrogate to himself the power to decide whether the Sultan had directed himself properly.

2. The High Court's astounding decision over the meaning of the words "day-to-day" takes the cake !! We are told that this judge is brilliant, honest, a true scholar of sorts etc.

But had he applied honest legal principles, it would have told him that a judge cannot import words into an Act of Parliament. The word "day-today" means what it says- one day to the next. It does not leave any room for the implication that it only covers office hours. Surely this honest, brilliant scholar must have known this !! But the decision he made, rendered him an overnight hero in the NGO community and with the consortium of liberals, the Bar Council etc. So despite knowing that his decision had the effect of stretching the meaning and language of the legislation to a breaking point- that was a price he was willing to pay.

To get a feel of this Judge it is worthwhile to investigate the trends in his decisions. It is interesting to find out why he is prepared to intervene in some cases on very questionable grounds and in other cases he is prepared to uphold decisions that defy precedent and logic. Could this trend be tied to the identity of the lawyers or firms that appear before him ? Is he one of those judges who is in the habit of giving decisions in favour of particular firms in order to ride a popular wave of their network ? Now that he is finally leaving that division an analysis will be helpful to find out where his integrity actually is.

3. We then have the famous judge who decided to punish an assemblyman for not attending the assembly although he was certified as ill.

An investigation should be carried out to find out why this decision was delivered after court hours. Why was it delayed from 2pm till close to or after 5.30pm. These are issues that the Bar Council should be asking- but since the decision favoured their franchise holder the questions are not being asked.


Perhaps we should ask the question of whether it is just for a speaker to declare the seat of an assemblyman vacant when he is certified as ill. Whatever suspicions we have over MCs if a person is certified as ill who is a High Court Judge or Speaker to say otherwise.

While we are at this, it is worthwhile reminding ourselves of a decision made by this same judge which declared that the flats constructed by the Selangor Government to house squatters was illegal. Here she has yet to write her grounds of decision for years after the headline grabbing decision which covered centre spreads weekend after weekend.

So when we talk of judicial independence let us not think that Judges are innocents waiting to do justice. Let us not be constantly suspicious of the executive trying to infiltrate the judiciary. Judges are people. Many of them are flawed people. Let's not kid ourselves. These people do not really sit there with a crystal clear conscience out to do justice. They come in with a host of prejudices, they sit there with grievances against the government, the CJ, the KPI system and keep relating the facts of the case and the arguments to these experiences. If Judges are truly dedicated to justice, then their decision must be the same irrespective of who appears before them and what they think of that person. How many times have we heard our judges say- "if you keep pressing this point see what will happen!" "If you keep persisting- its not good for your client".

Yet lawyers and the Bar are prepared to let all this go if the ultimate decision furthers an anti-establishment cause.


While we need scholarship and integrity in our judiciary, we must ensure that it is real scholarship and not just a perception of scholarship! Read the decisions of some of these judges whom the Bar hails as independent and you will see them in a new light- "by their fruit ye shall know them".
