1. British papers headlined "Blair's battle with law chief over Iraq". Tony Blair was told the Iraq war was illegal by Attorney-General (Lord Goldsmith) the day before he (Blair) gave George Bush the go-ahead for invasion.

4. When Bush said on January 31st 2003, that bombing (of Iraq) would begin in mid-March, David Manning, the PM's chief foreign policy adviser recorded Blair's reaction; "The Prime Minister said he was solidly behind the President".
5. It is not surprising therefore that the US has "honoured" Blair with a medal and GBP 67,000.
6. The award according to David Eisner of the National Constitution Centre of America is because "Tony Blair has significantly furthered the expansion of freedom, self governance, equality and peaceful co-existence". It is the height of hypocrisy.
7. Malaysian Achievers should be happy that they are not alone in their admiration of Tony Blair. But anti-war campaigners reacted furiously and Andrew Burgin of the Stop the War Coalition said, "This is unbelievable. It is a reward for supporting Bush in the war against Iraq".
8. "It is the deaths of a million people in Iraq that Blair should be remembered for".
9. True to his ilk, Blair supported Israel's attack and killings of aid workers of the humanitarian flotilla to Gaza. Blair considers Israel's attack and piracy in international waters as constituting a right to defend itself.
10. When Blair the war criminal came here to speak for RM1 million (GBP200,000) he was treated as a Government guest and given VIP treatment.
11. Personally I don't care for any special treatment for me when I travel abroad. But at Heathrow, London, I was treated as a terrorist. I had to take off my shoes, belt and coat and was body searched for weapons by British security before I was allowed to go through.
12. I was reminded of the Hindi film, starring Shah Rukh Khan entitled, "My name is Khan", in which Khan tried to meet the President of the United States to tell him, "Mr President, my name is Khan. I am not a terrorist".
13. I felt like shouting should I meet Mr Cameron, Prime Minister of the United Kingdom of England, Scotland and Northern Ireland, "Mr Prime Minister, my name is Mahathir. I am the former Prime Minister of Malaysia. I am not a terrorist".

14. But of course I will not do it. I will continue to be treated as a terrorist in the United Kingdom while Mr Moneybags war criminal Tony Blair will be given full VVIP treatment by the Malaysian Government when he visits Malaysia, a former British colony.

“Former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad said if Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) advisor Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim was loyal to Jewish groups, he could not be loyal to his own country.” (Bernama, 12 July 2010). Mahathir's son, Mirzan, worked for Salomon Brothers (a Jewish firm). Mahathir reconciled with George Soros, a Jew he once despised, when Soros visited Malaysia a few years ago and openly declared (for reasons which are still a mystery) that Soros had not been responsible for Malaysia's financial crisis.

Abramoff, a Jew, arranged a meeting between Mahathir and George Bush after Mahathir's government paid US\$1.2m to the Heritage Foundation managed by Abramoff. These are only just some of the Mahathir-Jewish partnerships. So who is the Jews' good friend? Mahathir or Anwar? Perhaps Dr. Mahathir is again suffering from his (convenient) mental lapses that he experienced during the Lingam enquiry (when he said that could not remember basic details) and has forgotten his partnerships and links with Jewish firms and individuals.

This has also been mentioned by Barry Wain in his book, the Malaysian Maverick.

//Umno speaks up when chips are down, analysts say By Yow Hong Chieh July 13, 2010 Muhyiddin's recent rhetoric was business as usual for Umno, say analysts.

1. KUALA LUMPUR, July 13 — Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin's recent use of increasingly strident race rhetoric is standard practice for Umno when faced with troubled times, say political commentators.
2. Political scientist Dr Farish Noor said Umno playing the race card was nothing new, and followed a pattern where the party would amplify parochialism whenever it was not strong enough to fend off challenges from the opposition or there was an internal leadership crisis.
3. "This use of ethno-nationalist discourse has always been part and parcel of Umno politics since the 70s," Farish told The Malaysian Insider.

4. He also said the deputy prime minister's constant harping on issues calculated to appeal to Malay voters was consistent with the historical role of his position as Umno deputy president.
5. "There's always been this history of this double act in Umno... It's not even a new script," Farish pointed out.
6. He said that Umno has to have two faces, with the prime minister acting as a "bridge-builder" to the non-Malays and the world while his deputy was responsible for unifying the party.
7. Farish pointed out that Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim played a similar role as Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad's second before his fall from favour in 1998.
8. Najib and Muhyiddin's (left) seemingly opposing voices fit a long-established Umno mould. — file pic"Anwar's task in the 80s was simple — to promote Umno's Islamic credentials and to harass PAS... [while] Dr Mahathir sold the idea of a developed Malaysia abroad," he said.
9. "We can go back and read all their speeches. Anwar was doing then what Muhyiddin's doing now."
10. Farish added that this arrangement was likely to persist for the foreseeable future, citing Umno's "institutional inertia" and resistance to change.
11. "If Muhyiddin became PM tomorrow, he would need someone to play the role he's playing now," the political scientist said.
12. Monash University Malaysia political scientist Dr James Chin argued that this "division of labour" between Najib and Muhyiddin showed that Umno had not learned anything from its disappointing performance in Election 2008.
13. "They still think they can talk to different communities using different media," he told The Malaysian Insider.
14. "The new media operates totally differently — it operates in all languages. It doesn't matter if you speak it in Tamil like Samy Vellu or in Mandarin like the MCA... You can't specify your message to one particular ethnic community anymore."
15. However, Chin said the party will continue to tell Malays to unite under Umno or lose the Malay state they claim the Malay nationalist party had successfully built since 1969.
16. "It is consistent with the overall product that they're selling, which is 'Ketuanan Melayu' (Malay dominance)," he said.
17. He also said the stark warnings issued by Umno in recent weeks laid the ground for the coming general election, which he claimed was just around the corner.
18. "They're just positioning themselves [for the general election]," Chin said.
19. "The general election is crucial for Najib. If he loses further ground then Umno will only allow him to stay for one term. If he manages to win big, then he'll be there for at least two terms."
20. Merdeka Center director Ibrahim Suffian concurred with Farish's assessment that Muhyiddin's recent dire warnings to Malays was business as usual.
21. "I'm not sure if there's anything new there," he said of Umno's attempt at conflating Malay political and economic well-being with Malay unity.

22. "Ethnic unity in times of economic uncertainty strikes the strongest chord."

23. Ibrahim also identified the Najib-Muhyiddin double act as an attempt to strike a balance between its non-Malay supporters and investors, and its Malay-centric support base.

24. "The results of [Election] 2008 have prompted them to address the grievances of the minorities but they've realised a lot of the changes... are uncomfortable to their base," he said.

25. "They have to keep the base."

26. However, the pollster argued that while Umno's rhetoric struck a chord with many working class and lower middle-class Malays, there was still a disconnect between the party's words and the situation on the ground.

27. "Part of the rhetoric doesn't meet the reality they (the Malays) are confronted with," he said, citing rising inflation as well as the lack of job opportunities and access to government assistance for urban Malays.

28. "Malays living in urban areas generally fall out of the ambit of government assistance," Ibrahim added.

29. While he admitted that it will be hard for Umno to keep to race-based politics while leading a multi-ethnic coalition, Ibrahim nonetheless defended the Barisan Nasional (BN) solution as having the potential to occupy the centre ground of Malaysian politics through "best compromises".

30. "It (the coalition) is supposed to bring moderation and I think that's how it was designed by the country's forefathers."

31. "What becomes a problem is when representatives from one group see themselves as having greater rights than others," Ibrahim said.//

I considered titling my talk today: "Malaysia-U.S. Defense Cooperation: The Untold Story." The reason is that for many years U.S. and Malaysian forces have cooperated on a wide range of missions with virtually no fanfare or public acknowledgement. And in spite of its success, our bilateral defense relationship seems to be an all too well-kept secret.

So I very much appreciate the chance The Heritage Foundation and the Center for Strategic and International Studies have provided for me to reveal this well-kept secret. I would particularly like to thank Dr. Ed Feulner of Heritage, not only for his kind introduction, but also for his ongoing contributions to enhancing Malaysia-U.S. understanding. I'd like to thank Dr. John Hamre as well, both for the hospitality CSIS is providing today and for his leadership on defense issues. Dr. Hamre may be among the few to whom our bilateral defense cooperation is not in fact a secret.

Before I begin, I'd like to touch briefly on our bilateral relationship as a whole--as a kind of preview to Prime Minister Mahathir's official visit to Washington in two weeks.

Certainly, I am aware that a visit by a head of state to Washington, D.C., is not a rare occurrence, especially these days. So why is this particular visit significant?

Historically, Malaysia has been a steady, reliable friend of the United States. Our multitude of common interests include trade and investment on a sizeable scale and security cooperation across a range of fronts. An equally important point is the common values our two countries share, including a commitment to democracy, religious tolerance, and equality for all our diverse citizens. In times like these--in a time of war--it is these values that bind nations together.

But I would point out that there is still another factor that makes our relationship important. Malaysia--though a small country halfway around the globe--occupies a somewhat unique position. We are an Islamic country. We are stable. We are prosperous. And our Prime Minister, Dr. Mahathir, has gained a certain status and sway, not only in the Southeast Asian region, but throughout the Islamic world.

#### An Unsung Story

I would like to elaborate on this subject later, but--to alleviate any suspense--I will first address the unsung story of our defense cooperation.

Take the recent hit film *Black Hawk Down*. The scene was Somalia, 1993. And although Hollywood saw it differently--I guess you could say Malaysia's role was left on the cutting room floor--the fact is this: More than 100 Malaysian peacekeeping forces engaged in that fierce fighting to try to rescue the trapped U.S. Army Rangers. Fighting together with the U.S. Rangers, one of our troops made the ultimate sacrifice, along with the 18 U.S. soldiers who died.

Fortunately, our troops do not serve to become stars in Hollywood.

We were indeed gratified, however, when we were honored by the Pentagon for our contributions. And then, in New York this past March, a total of 23 Malaysian peacekeepers were awarded the Dag Hammarskjöld Medal, which is presented by the United Nations to peacekeepers killed in the line of duty.

In fact, since 1960, Malaysia has participated in more than 20 United Nations missions, from East Timor to Kosovo. For Malaysia, peacekeeping operations are an integral part of our foreign policy. Like the United States, we believe that nations--even small ones--have the responsibility to contribute when and wherever possible to a stable world order.

#### A Special Relationship with the U.S.

Malaysian forces regularly conduct joint training with United States counterparts, and the United States routinely enjoys access to Malaysian airfields and ports. Also, Malaysia provides one of the few bases outside the United States for U.S. military jungle-warfare training. U.S. troops are warmly welcomed in Malaysia and enjoy training there. In particular:

There have been more than 75 U.S. military ship visits in the past two and a half years. The United States conducts training exercises with the Royal Malaysian Air Force, flying with and against them in mock battles.

U.S. Navy SEALs conduct training in Malaysia twice a year.

The U.S. Army does field exercises with the Malaysian army. I might mention here that, for their expertise in jungle warfare, Malaysians are known in the business as "whispering death."

Finally, 1,500 Malaysian defense personnel have benefited from the U.S.-sponsored IMET (international military education and training) program.

As you can see, cooperation between our two nations started long before September 11, 2001. But the horrific events of that day galvanized our relationship as never before. Prime Minister Mahathir has been vocal in condemning the attacks, and we have been happy to provide an elevated level of cooperation with the United States on the range of fronts. For example:

The United States averages more than 1,000 overflights per year. Since September 11, this number has increased dramatically, and all requests have been approved.

The United States has excellent access to Malaysian intelligence.

Malaysia occupies a strategic location along the Strait of Malacca and southern South China Sea, and devotes considerable resources to maintaining safe and free shipping lanes for commercial and military vessels. Since September 11, Malaysian forces have been protecting U.S. ships in the Strait.

Malaysia has a considerable number of troops and military assets on our islands to thwart the threat of Abu Sayyaf terrorists in the Southern Philippines.

In addition, Malaysia is actively identifying assets of terrorists and teaching Indonesia and other ASEAN (Association of Southeast Asian Nations) countries how to freeze assets.

//RPK says will return if no ISA for him

1. LONDON, July 10 — Going to musicals, enjoying dinner with a group of Malaysian friends until 11pm, and speaking at public events.
2. Raja Petra Kamarudin, the controversial blogger that the Malaysian police claims it is actively hunting, hardly seems like a man in hiding.
3. Or, as many reports have put it, a fugitive.
4. It is a term he bristles at. He said detention without trial is the only thing stopping him from returning home to Malaysia.
5. "Why am I being called a fugitive, or runaway, or worse, that I absconded? Like I embezzled money and fled the country," he told The Malaysian Insider in an exclusive interview here.
6. The writer of the No Holds Barred column in web portal, Malaysia Today, insisted that since he is not convicted of any crime and nor were there any standing charges or arrest warrants, he cannot possibly be classified as a fugitive.
7. He also does not have to appear for the appeal against his release from the Internal Security Act (ISA), a law that allows for detention without trial at the prerogative of the home minister, a case which has seen no progress since Raja Petra left Malaysia in May 2009 .
8. However, critics point out that he was not in the country when an arrest warrant was issued after he failed to show up for the hearing on a criminal defamation charge last year, resulting in a discharge not amounting to an acquittal in November as the police failed to execute the warrant.
9. But the man known by his initials, RPK, claimed he left the country not because he wanted to flee charges of sedition and criminal defamation, but that his sources had informed him that a new ISA detention order was being prepared at the time.

10. "We were winning all the court cases. We were making the government look stupid. My lawyers to this day regret that we had to leave," he said of the charges levelled at him due to his accusation that Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak and his wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, were involved in the death of Mongolian translator Altantuya Shariibuu, and a related submarine deal that French authorities are now investigating for an alleged irregularity in commission payment, said to amount to a whopping RM500 million.

11. To back his claim, he issued an open offer to Najib to "guarantee me that I will not be placed under ISA and forget another six charges I know they were preparing, and I will come back and fight the sedition and criminal defamation cases."

12. Raja Petra has spent the past few months calling what appears to be the government's bluff. When police insisted they were still trying to track his whereabouts, he came out to speak in public in May, claiming the Barisan Nasional government knew all along as he had met various Umno figures in the United Kingdom over the past year.

13. He also told The Malaysian Insider in this interview that his lawyers have informed Scotland Yard that he was available to them anytime, and he has also challenged the government to attempt to extradite him.

14. Raja Petra was confident that it has not done so as such an attempt would, he claimed, play into his hands.

15. "With sedition and criminal defamation, the truth of the matter is not material, only whether the statement has caused hurt. But to extradite me, they have to establish dual criminality."

16. His point was that a case in a UK court would be based on a different charge that would have to establish whether his allegations against Najib and Rosmah were true, as these two crimes — sedition and criminal defamation — have been abolished in the UK early this year.

17. But perhaps the one thing that irked him more than being called a fugitive is the idea that he has required funding during his stay in the UK, having left Malaysia over a year ago.

18. Both Najib and Datuk Mukhriz Mahathir, a deputy minister, have claimed that Raja Petra is not trustworthy as he is funded by the opposition.

19. "You think I pokai (penniless) ah? You don't know how much property I own, or shares, or any of my financial background.

20. "Do you know how many public-listed companies I was director of in the 1980s?" he said as he laughed off the notion that he was bankrupt.

21. He explained that he was sent a letter giving him 14 days to contest his bankruptcy on April 14, 2001 but this was only three days into his 60-day stint under his first ISA detention.

22. "The man I was supposed to have guaranteed was Datuk Hamzah Zainuddin, who has accused Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim of harassing his wife. Why would I have guaranteed such a person?" he said, alleging a frame-up.

23. "But in any case, everyone knows you can put assets in your wife's name or your daughter's name."

24. For now, he is happy to continue taunting Najib's administration, and in his most recent column entry, he told the government to stop harassing other individuals with regards to funding him or another central figure in the Altantuya saga, the private investigator P. Balasubramaniam hired by Abdul Razak Baginda, a close associate of Najib's who was being harassed by the Mongolian.

WOMEN

by Nurit Peled-Elhanan

Thank you for inviting me to this today. It is always an honour and a pleasure to be here, among you (at the European Parliament).

However, I must admit I believe you should have invited a Palestinian woman at my stead, because the women who suffer most from violence in my county are the Palestinian women. And I would like to dedicate my speech to Miriam R`aban and her husband Kamal, from Bet Lahiya in the Gaza strip, whose five small children were killed by Israeli soldiers while picking strawberries at the family`s strawberry field. No one will ever stand trial for this murder.

When I asked the people who invited me here why didn't they invite a Palestinian woman, the answer was that it would make the discussion too localized.

I don't know what is non-localized violence. Racism and discrimination may be theoretical concepts and universal phenomena but their impact is always local, and real. Pain is local, humiliation, sexual abuse, torture and death, are all very local, and so are the scars.

It is true, unfortunately, that the local violence inflicted on Palestinian women by the government of Israel and the Israeli army, has expanded around the globe, In fact, state violence and army violence, individual and collective violence, are the lot of Muslim women today, not only in Palestine but wherever the enlightened western world is setting its big imperialistic foot. It is violence which is hardly ever addressed and which is halfheartedly condoned by most people in Europe and in the USA.

This is because the so-called free world is afraid of the Muslim womb.

Great France of "la liberte egalite et la fraternite" is scared of little girls with head scarves. Great Jewish Israel is afraid of the Muslim womb which its ministers call a demographic threat.

Almighty America and Great Britain are infecting their respective citizens with blind fear of the Muslims, who are depicted as vile, primitive and blood-thirsty, apart from their being non-democratic, chauvinistic and mass producers of future terrorists. This in spite of the fact that the people who are destroying the world today are not Muslim. One of them is a devout Christian, one is Anglican and one is a non-devout Jew.

I have never experienced the suffering Palestinian women undergo every day, every hour, I don't know the kind of violence that turns a woman's life into constant hell. This daily physical and mental torture of women who are deprived of their basic human rights and needs of privacy and dignity, women whose homes are broken into at any moment of day and night, who are ordered at a gun-point to strip naked in front of strangers and their own children, whose houses are demolished , who are deprived of their livelihood and of any normal family life. This is not part of my personal ordeal.

But I am a victim of violence against women insofar as violence against children is actually violence against mothers. Palestinian, Iraqi, Afghan women are my sisters because we are all at the grip of the same unscrupulous criminals who call themselves leaders of the free enlightened world and in the name of this freedom and enlightenment rob us of our children.

Furthermore, Israeli, American, Italian and British mothers have been for the most part violently blinded and brainwashed to such a degree that they cannot realize their only sisters, their only allies in the world are the Muslim Palestinian, Iraqi or Afghani mothers, whose children are killed by our children or who blow themselves to pieces with our sons and daughters. They are all mind-infected by the same viruses engendered by politicians. And the viruses , though they may have various illustrious names--such as Democracy, Patriotism, God, Homeland--are all the same. They are all part of false and fake ideologies that are meant to enrich the rich and to empower the powerful.

We are all the victims of mental, psychological and cultural violence that turn us to one homogenic group of bereaved or potentially bereaved mothers.. Western mothers who are taught to believe their uterus is a

national asset just like they are taught to believe that the Muslim uterus is an international threat. They are educated not to cry out: 'I gave him birth, I breast fed him, he is mine, and I will not let him be the one whose life is cheaper than oil, whose future is less worth than a piece of land.'

All of us are terrorized by mind-infecting education to believe all we can do is either pray for our sons to come back home or be proud of their dead bodies.

And all of us were brought up to bear all this silently, to contain our fear and frustration, to take Prozac for anxiety, but never hail Mama Courage in public. Never be real Jewish or Italian or Irish mothers.

I am a victim of state violence. My natural and civil rights as a mother have been violated and are violated because I have to fear the day my son would reach his 18th birthday and be taken away from me to be the game tool of criminals such as Sharon, Bush, Blair and their clan of blood-thirsty, oil-thirsty, land thirsty generals..

Living in the world I live in, in the state I live in, in the regime I live in, I don't dare to offer Muslim women any ideas how to change their lives. I don't want them to take off their scarves, or educate their children differently, and I will not urge them to constitute Democracies in the image of Western democracies that despise them and their kind. I just want to ask them humbly to be my sisters, to express my admiration for their perseverance and for their courage to carry on, to have children and to maintain a dignified family life in spite of the impossible conditions my world in putting them in. I want to tell them we are all bonded by the same pain, we all the victims of the same sort of violence even though they suffer much more, for they are the ones who are mistreated by my government and its army, sponsored by my taxes.

Islam in itself, like Judaism in itself and Christianity in itself, is not a threat to me or to anyone. American imperialism is, European indifference and co-operation is and Israeli racism and its cruel regime of occupation is. It is racism, educational propoganda and inculcated xenophobia that convince Israeli soldiers to order Palestinian women at gun-point, to strip in front of their children for security reasons, it is the deepest disrespect for the other that allow American soldiers to rape Iraqi women, that give license to Israeli jailers to keep young women in inhuman conditions, without necessary hygienic aids, without electricity in the winter, without clean water or clean mattresses and to separate them from their breast-fed babies and toddlers. To bar their way to hospitals, to block their way to education, to confiscate their lands, to uproot their trees and prevent them from cultivating their fields.

I cannot completely understand Palestinian women or their suffering. I don't know how I would have survived such humiliation, such disrespect from the whole world. All I know is that the voice of mothers has been suffocated for too long in this war-stricken planet. Mothers` cry is not heard because mothers are not invited to international forums such as this one. This I know and it is very little. But it is enough for me to remember these women are my sisters, and that they deserve that I should cry for them, and fight for them. And when they lose their children in strawberry fields or on filthy roads by the checkpoints, when their children are shot on their way to school by Israeli children who were educated to believe that love and compassion are race and religion dependent, the only thing I can do is stand by them and their betrayed babies, and ask what Anna Akhmatova--another mother who lived in a regime of violence against women and children--asked:

Why does that streak o blood, rip the petal of your cheek?

Ayah saya masuk FELDA pada tahun 1971. Masu tu kawasan FELDA saya masih dikelilingi hutan banat, hari-hari boleh tengok babi hutan, gajah, harimau dan binatang liar. Tapi atas kemahuan ayah saya untuk mengubah hidup anak-anaknya, semua halangan bukanlah masalah besar. Ayah saya bekerja secara berkelompok dalam menanam pokok kelapa sawit pada masa itu, satu "kong" (sekali pergi ladang) dibayar rm 2.50. Cukup untuk kasi pagi makan petang masa tu. Bila dah berbuah, satu blok A berkongsi hasil buah dan dibahagi sama rata hasilnya. Ada yang pemalas dan ada yang rajin. Yang pemalas hidup senang (sbb tak perlu kerja kuat), yang rajin dapat rezeki halal. Masa tu harga buah tandan kelapa sawit murah, jadi kalau dapat banyak, adalah peluang beli motor baru, tu pun bayar muka saja. FELDA sebenarnya tak banyak membantu peneroka meningkatkan pendapatan dari tahun 1971 hingga 2000. Sebabnya, dari gaji dari ibupejabat FELDA (paysheet besar), macam-macam dipotong termasuklah dari majalah FELDA yang berharga RM 10 (pada tahun 1980 harga RM 10 majalah tersebut adalah mahal. Bila sampai ke FELDA saya, pengurus FELDA potong lagi, koperasilah (yang langsung tak guna), masjid, kenduri-kendara, kantin (kantin adalah pasaraya bagi peneroka, harga barang selalunya 30-50% tinggi dari kedai luar. Peneroka terpaksa ambil sebab wang tunai dan sumber lain pun tak ada. Pengurus kantin dan pekerjaanya tulis harga barang atas kertas, walaupun harga barang mahal tapi tak boleh nak complen sebab tak tau nak rujuk ke mana) atau apa saja yang boleh digunakan untuk memotong hasil gaji peneroka. Bila ladang berbuah banyak, dapat rm 1000 lebih, peneroka mula beli kereta. Sebabnya dalam satu tahun nak dapat banyak tu, memang susah. Dan orang luar nampak peneroka FELDA kaya sebab boleh beli kereta tetapi realitinya dalam setengah tahun kereta kena tarik balik sebab tak mampu bayar hutang bulanan kereta. Kursus-kursus untuk peneroka tak ada langsung, FELDA tak mau berusaha pun untuk memajukan peneroka pada masa itu. FELDA adalah FELDA, yang kaya dan senang lenang adalah pengurusan pertengahan dan tertinggi FELDA. Gaji besar-besar, rumah besar, kereta besar tapi yang mati bekerja adalah peneroka. Mohon Ayahanda Tun lihat sekarang, berapa ramai anak peneroka FELDA yang menjawa jawatan pengurusan pertengahan dan tertinggi dalam FELDA. Mungkin ada tapi tak banyak. Yang banyak adalah anak-anak pengurusan pertengahan dan tertinggi FELDA dalam jawatan sekarang. Jika anak-anak peneroka FELDA tidak menjawat jawatan yang tinggi dalam FELDA, sehingga berapa generasi peneroka yang perlu kita tunggu untuk melihat peneroka menjadi kaya? Sebagai contoh, Ayahanda Tun membangunkan Langkawi semasa jadi PM, Pak Lah majukan Kepala Batas semasa jadi PM, Dato Seri Najib bangunkan Pekan sekarang, jadi kalau tiada anak-anak peneroka dalam pengurusan tertinggi FELDA, siapa yang nak bangunkan kawasan tanah rancangan FELDAnya? Menteri Pusat datang 4 tahun sekali sebab pilihanraya. Alhamdulillah, YB Tengku Azlan selalu jengok tanah rancangan saya. FELDA saya tak berubah semenjak 1971 sehingga sekarang selain jalan tanah

merah ditukar dengan jalan tar. Rumah guru tahun 1971 masih kekal seperti keadaan asalnya. Begitu juga dengan Klinik Kesihatan, masjid, balairaya. Perpustakaan tak ada, air masih kotor sehingga sekarang, elektrik masih macam chipmore (sekejap ada selalu takda).  
Apa yang FELDA buat untuk pembangunan kampung peneroka? Tak ada sebenarnya. Buat apa duit dan harta RM 11 billion kalau duit itu tidak digunakan untuk menjaga kebajikan peneroka? Anak-anak peneroka sudah ramai yang berjawatan professor, doktor, PHD, Master, dan ramai lagi yang berpangkat tinggi dalam tentera, polis, APMM, jabatan-jabatan kerajaan, Syarikat-syarikat minyak, swasta dan sebagainya. Soalnya, adakah FELDA ambil mereka untuk menjawat jawatan penting dalam pengurusan tertinggi FELDA?????? Cuba Ayahanda Tun tanya, berapa ramai peneroka sekarang yang mengikuti kursus penanaman kelapa sawit, getah, tebu. Berapa ramai peneroka yang mengikuti kursus menternak puyuh, ayam, kambing, lembu yang dianjurkan FELDA? Jika tak berkursus, bagaimana nak pandai, bagaimana nak membela binatang ternakan dengan baik, bagaimana nak menjaga pokok kelapa sawit, getah dan tebu dengan baik supaya mendapat hasil yang banyak. Sebab tak ada kursus anjuran FELDA itulah saya rasa, lebih ramai anak peneroka yang menjadi "doktor", cucuk jarum ke badan sendiri untuk masukkan dadah. Dan kerajaan salahkan peneroka sebab tak jaga anak sendiri. Betullah tu. Bila harga buah naik, FELDA untung besar. Buah kelapa sawit banyak dan harga mahal. FELDA beri pilihan untuk peneroka serahkan ladang kepada FELDA untuk diusahakan tetapi setiap bulan diberi RM 1500.00. Peneroka tua-tua (yang dah tak larat nak kerja) dan isteri-isteri peneroka yang kematian suami terpaksa serah kepada FELDA. Ada juga yang tak serah kepada FELDA tetapi pendapatan bulanan cecah RM 9000 hingga berbelas2 ribu. Siapa yang untung? Pengurusan FELDA. Koperasi FELDA memiliki lori-lori untuk mengangkut buah kelapa sawit ke ladang-ladang setiap hari. Kos pengangkutan dibayar oleh peneroka dan dipotong mengikut berapa tan buah kelapa sawit yang dihantar ke kilang. Kos pengangkutan diserahkan kepada Koperasi tetapi setiap tahun keuntungan koperasi FELDA tak nampak. Yang untung, orang yang memegang jawatan dalam Koperasi. Saya mohon audit dijalankan kepada KOPERASI FELDA SG TEKAM UTARA, JERANTUT dan jika berlaku penyelewengan, SPRM minta siasat. FELDA saya adalah kawasan kuat UMNO tetapi FELDA PADANG PIOL, kawasan kuat PAS boleh memiliki SYARIKAT BAS KUALA TAHAN yang boleh bersaing dengan SYARIKAT BAS TRANSNASIONAL.
