//Legal lion roars and mauls Share

OPINION THE integrity of the judiciary has been badly mauled by a legal lion who does not mince his words no matter how high or mighty a judge thinks he is.

In recent comments in news portals, former Court of Appeal judge N H Chan has called certain members of the judiciary 'incompetent' and even 'an idiotic bunch!'

Chief Justice Zaki Azmi and the judges at the Palace of Justice have remained mum, mute and mumble amongst themselves as Chan methodically makes them out for who they really are and the mockery they have made of the law!

The respected, renowned and retired judge is very frustrated, fed-up and furious at how the judiciary which he had served so faithfully has been reduced to a farce run by those he called legal and intellectual frauds or 'imposters.'

With each passing compromised judgment Chan unhesitatingly hits out at judges with an increasingly sharper sting.

He leaves no stone unturned, no errant judge uncovered. They can 'no longer mask their hyperbole judgments with unintelligible garbage.'

Fools on the bench

Chan said in his latest scathing critique that the rakyat is "stunned by the ignorance of our judges of the highest court in the land."

This, he claimed, was seen in the recent Federal Court's decision not to review Anwar Ibrahim's application to review its previous decision dismissing his application for disclosure of documents for his second sodomy trial.

Chan said the Federal Court's approach to Rule 137 of the Rules of the Federal Court 1995 was 'inconsistent' and 'dishonest' and 'those ignoramuses' were talking 'utter nonsense.'

Calling the three-member panel of Zulkefli Ahmad Makinuddin, Mohd Ghazali Mohd Yusoff and Heliliah Mohd Yusof 'incompetent', he added: "Perhaps, they are clowns as their statements are laughable".

His searing criticism was that they "do not know justice from injustice" and that "such lowly individuals should never be allowed to sit on the seat of Justice...(and) to be judges at all.

"And yet there are so many of them in the judiciary today ever since the rot begun."

"The common citizenry can now uncover the impostors hiding beneath the mantle of the judicature.

"They have put themselves beyond the pale. Just like pariahs. Don't you think they should be despised?" he asked.

On the rejection by High Court judge Mohamad Zabidin Mohd Diah of Anwar's application to have the judge recuse himself from further hearing the sodomy trial, Chan said that the judge was talking "utter nonsense" and "knew next to nothing about judicial bias".

He added that the "moral of this unsavoury episode" is: if you appoint mediocre lawyers to the Bench you will get substandard judges.

The solution to this problem, he said, is simple. "Appoint judges from the cream of the legal profession and you will not find me assailing the judges for incompetence simply because I will not be able to do so."

Spares no judges

Chan had not spared the judges in the cases related to the Perak constitutional crisis of his very strong language when scrutinising their decisions (with the exception of Kuala Lumpur High Court Justice Abdul Aziz Abdul Rahim whom he had praised).

During the Perak debacle Chan had said that there are "many of our judges today, especially among those judges in the higher echelon of the judicial hierarchy, who do not seem to know the true meaning of separation of powers in constitutional law.

He called some of the judges of the cases of the Perak imbroglio:

Bad judges – "They seem to think that independence means that they can do what they like"

Recalcitrant judges – "They think that words can mean whatever they want them to mean"

Humpty Dumpty judges – "They also think that they are independent of the legislature".

Chan said the Perak crisis showed that the judges gave the impression that they were one-sided. "The perception of the people is that they sided with the Barisan Nasional government."

Reputation of the judiciary

The public shares his view. In their eyes the judiciary has allowed itself to be intimidated, its independence and impartiality interfered with, and its integrity reduced to ignominy.

In the light of Chan's severe criticism of the judiciary (which is quite unprecedented by a retired judge), surely the Chief Justice cannot stand idly, silently and stoically by – unless Zaki strenuously, staunchly and solemnly agrees with him!

Further if Zaki continues to remain silent the public will assume that he shares Chan's searing criticism of the judiciary. Logically he would have to resign for he has allowed the reputation of the judiciary to be sullied irreparably.

The judicial shenanigans who Chan has criticized and castigated should also resign for having shamelessly sacrificed justice on the altar of political expediency.

Chan's comments on members of the judiciary have no doubt been bold, blunt and blistering. He has accused judges of being blind, biased and being a bunch of 'idiots' and 'fools.'. He has thrown the gauntlet down.

If the CJ disagrees with Chan's criticisms he should haul the former Court of Appeal judge into court and demand that the latter shows cause for why he should not be cited for contempt! Will Zaki take up the gauntlet or will he prefer to allow the judicial circus to go on?

Chan has made no bones about it. His blitzkrieg on the judiciary will continue.

"Bad guys" beware! He will ensure that their names remain in infamy for generations to come unless they recant the wrongs that they have done!

He commented: "At the present time and judging by what we have experienced so far from the Perak takeover cases, the quality of most of our judges is suspect".

Revving to go on the F1 track Share

KUALA LUMPUR - Expectation is high on the Malaysian camp as its Lotus Racing F1 team prepares to rev up at Bahrain's Sakhir circuit this weekend, when the 2010 Formula 1 season kicks off.

The team has big plans to seize a world championship in future but for now it remains modest of its chances though it is prepared to spring some surprises.

Speaking at a press conference here on Friday, the eve of the team's departure for the first leg of the circuit, team leader Tony Fernandes said Bahrain is a hard race to start.

"It's very hot, dry and there is sand. So, it's a baptism of fire for us.

"But, hey, you got to start somewhere! So, let's hope that we finish the race. The great thing is that anything can happen.

"For me, personally, if we can finish the race that will be great. Everything above that will be a bonus, whether we come last, second last or third last."

Fernandes, who heads budget carrier AirAsia, added: "The important thing is we are on the grid.

For him and deputy team principal Kamarudin Meranun, the last eight years had been non-stop excitement in building the airline.

But, he said, Lotus Racing is "something else."

"To be there and qualifying with the likes of Ferrari, McLaren, Renault and Red Bull – teams that have been around for a long time - it's fantastic.

"To be able to have the Malaysian flag on the car and, hopefully, one day, the national anthem 'Negaraku' will be played at the race. We hope all Malaysians are proud of this.

"No Malaysian should be looking at where we come from because no Asian country - with the exception of Japan and India - has done it.

"The key is to finish the race. Just like AirAsia, you start small and slowly build it."

Racing from the back

Fernandes admits the team would be competing "at the back" in Bahrain.

He, however, is pleased with their three drivers - (pic, from right) Jarno Trulli, Heikki Kovalainen and Fairuz Fauzi.

"They get on so well together. They are really working and helping each other and having some fun."

He said the fact that the team has Trulli and Kovalainen is a testament to the team itself.

"Kovalainen was in McLaren, which has been world champion many times. For him to know that this year he will be at the back shows his belief in our ability to grow.

"Hopefully, he'll get up there and compete with the front guys in the not too distant future."

Fantastic role model

Fernandes said there was initially a lot of concern about the engine.

"The Cosworth is a new engine. All the teams that are using Cosworth are very happy with the engine. It has given good power and good reliability.

"And Lotus has always been linked with Cosworth. The famous Lotus cars were Cosworth-powered."

Regarding Fairuz, Fernandes said: "He's so calm, very determined and I think he is a fantastic role model for all Malaysians.

"He's been very professional, very positive, never let anything knock him down and I hope we can make his dream (to drive in the race) come true soon.

"He is going to be the first driver to test the Lotus T127 in Bahrain, taking out the car for the first practice.

"He was also the first guy to drive the T127 in Jerez, Spain.

"The car was not fitted with power steering then but he drove 72 laps without power steering to get his super licence. He did a fantastic job; he never complained.

"He is very positive and he did some good times. He kept the car on the track and he's a fantastic guy; a fantastic asset to the team."

Fernandes further said: "I think the proudest thing is that even the Americans (USF1) didn't get to the grid despite starting three months before us.

Important to Malaysia

He said the Malaysian leg of the circuit at Sepang is the most important for the team.

"It's our homecoming. We haven't had the chance to bring the car home to Malaysia yet as we only have two chassis and no show car.

"The Malaysian race is the most important in the season for us. We want the whole of Malaysia to see the car and feel part of it," adding that his team plans to do an event at the Pavillion KL when the cars are here at the end of the month.

"Since we do not have a show car, we'll put one up and you're going to be seeing the real car. This is the car that we will be racing in in Sepang. Other teams will bring show cars but ours is going to be the real car.

On sponsorships, he said: "The good thing about sponsor source is that although they know you

will be driving from the back, we are getting more publicity than even Ferrari.

"It's probably what we've been good at – getting good PR and good mileage. We are getting a lot of response from sponsors, also because of the coverage we are getting.

"Also, Lotus is fantastic name. And I suppose the battle with Richard Branson will guarantee some coverage – yes, it is still on, there's no going back.

Fernandes and fellow aviation mogul Branson, who is launching Virgin Racing in 2010, have a madcap cross-dressing bet on whose team will win.

If the Malaysian tycoon loses, he will have to be stewardess on Branson's aircraft and if Branson loses he has to be a stewardess on AirAsia. Routes have been picked, the Virgin boss will do the London-Kuala Lumpur route while Fernandes will do London-Lagos.

The branding and merchandise

On why he is using the Tune Group on the racing car instead of the AirAsia brand, Fernandes said: "AirAsia is already well established. And we already have a contract with AT&T Williams F1 Team.

"I don't think AirAsia will be on a Lotus car anyway. AirAsia has reached a certain level but Tune Group is now up and coming. Tune Hotels.com is opening 15 hotels in London. Tune Money and Tune Talk are growing rapidly too.

Asked about the Lotus Racing merchandise, he said the team will start selling in Bahrain.

Regarding the comeback of Michael Schumacher in the circuit, Fernandes said: "It's great for him to be back in F1.

"It also shows that our timing was perfect. It's going to be great for Malaysia; the amount of branding that Malaysia got over the last six months has been fantastic for 1Malaysia.

"It really brings us together as well and it really fits in with the 1Malaysia concept. For us it's good for Malaysia because there's going to be a lot of interest in F1. - Malaysian Mirror

Not a practical idea

THE Education Ministry has announced that sports activities will be made compulsory in all schools starting next year and each student will be required to select a game.

Assuredly, there are merits in promoting sports activities and a sports culture in schools.

But has sufficient thought been given to the practicality of making it compulsory for every student to select a game?

Consider a normal secondary school with 2,000 students.

If this school has facilities, equipment and coaches for 10 games, we are talking about 200 students taking part in one game on the average.

Now, take badminton as an example.

If you have two pairs playing doubles in a court and another two pairs taking turns during any training session, you will need 25 courts for all players.

Even if you have five sessions, you still need five courts.

How many normal schools have that many badminton courts? One training session a week is no way to produce champions!

What about football, with 22 players on the field during a game?

If each team has 20 players, there will be five teams. If all are to train at the same time, two fields are not enough.

If training is on different days, you will still need a field.

How many schools have a proper football field?

Making it compulsory for students to select a game is not new.

Years ago, the ministry made it compulsory for every student to select a game, join an academic society and be a member of a uniformed body.

Schools complied but only on paper.

Most students registered three activities and that was about all that had happened as most schools had neither the facility nor the ability to cope.

The idea of compulsory mass participation was simply not practical.

Let the schools decide on what games they can have based on the resources available.

Let students who are inclined and have potential make their own choice.

Making it compulsory for every student to select a game is neither beneficial to the students nor practical.

Compulsory mass participation is not the way to produce champions.

Sports champions, like all other endeavours, are made of the better endowed, or even the elite

few.

If the objective is to promote a sports culture through mass participation in sports activities, consider other methods.

First, we should consider requiring all schools to seriously carry out “taking standards” in sports.

The sets of “standards” required are already established in the Physical and Health Education syllabus.

Every student is required, according to his age group, to achieve certain predetermined standards in some basic sports activities and agility like long jump, high jump, discus throwing, long distance and short distance runs.

For the more athletic inclined, this can be a breeze.

For the less sports endowed, they need to practise to achieve the required standards.

The important thing is students are taught and exposed to what constitutes basic sports agility which is important in life.

The once-popular school cross-country runs should be revived.

As each student has a different ability, different routes can be designed to cater for different groups.

But every student should learn to run a cross-country race.

It entails both physical as well as character development and will also help students to discard a sedentary lifestyle later in life.
