KUALA LUMPUR - The perception that Umno is no longer relevant is portrayed by desperadoes and those who left the party, said its secretary-general, Tengku Adnan Tengku Mansor.

"They are not able to get what they desired from Umno so they create a perception that the party is not relevant," he said in an interview with umno-online.com in conjunction with the party's 64th anniversary Tuesday.

Despite the negative perception bandied about, he said Umno membership increased over the years, including among the younger generation.

"I believe as long as the Malays live, Umno will continue to be the prime mover in ensuring the rights of our children, nation and Islam are not compromised," he said.

No other Malay party could champion the fate of the Malays, Islam and the country as Umno did, he said, adding that, even PAS was an Umno splinter party.

Umno ready to readmit dissidents

"If we look back at the history, when Ahmad Fuad lost the contest for Umno presidency against Tunku Abdul Rahman (Putra Al-Haj), he left the party and vowed in Gunung Semangol that wherever there was Umno, PAS would destroy it. That is the reason why PAS was set up," he said.

Similarly, he said Tengku Razaleigh Hamzah set up Semangat 46, another Umno splinter party, when he lost the contest for the presidency against Dr Mahathir Mohamad but fortunately he rejoined the party.

Tengku Adnan said former Umno deputy president Anwar Ibrahim set up Keadilan (now Parti Keadilan Rakyat) out of his disappointment.

"The party has no direction, no clear cause in championing the Malay rights, Islam and the nation," he said, adding that there may be more splinter parties set up by disappointed Umno members.

"As they are frustrated, we do not know what are their aspirations and intentions. Sometimes they do things which can destroy the country," he added.

He said Umno was willing to readmit them back although they derided the party before.

"We do not want the Malays to be in disarray. If the Malays are weak, believe me Malaysia will be topsy-turvy," he said when commenting Umno veteran Aziz Tape's remarks that, "Without Umno, the Malays will fade away."

"It is true. The Malays is Umno. Umno is the Malays. The problem is most Malays do not know the history. When they wake up, everything is there, schools, roads, infrastructure. They do not study how these things came about," he said.

On the attitude of some members who underestimate the changes and transformation in Umno, he said, "Even if you want to renovate a house, someone might oppose it and give differing views.

Conviction in party's struggle

"I believe what the president (Najib Abdul Razak) does is for the good of the nation. In order to ensure the party's survival, we must do things to suit the time," he said.

He said that Umno leaders and members must realise, appreciate and interpret their conviction in the party's struggle.

"What is important, we joined Umno to ensure that the rights of the Malays will not be trampled. Not for personal or individual gains.

"Anyone who wants to contest any position can offer himself, but I would advise, we must understand the reason why we joined the party. We hold the trust. Not to get something for ourselves.

"If the fundamental goal is wrong, believe me, we will be despondent, regret and eventually disappointed. Just look at our friends who have jumped ship," he said.

As such, he said party members should not be enamoured with leaders as they come and go while the party's struggle to improve the well-being of the people continued.

On the 64th Umno anniversary, he said every division and branch must fly the Umno flag Tuesday.

He said a motorcycle expedition to the Holy Land would be flagged off at the Umno headquarters at the Putra World Trade Centre followed by a Maghrib and tahlil prayers at the Tun Razak 4 Hall from 6.30pm Tuesday.

At the function, the prime minister is scheduled to present awards to eminent Malays.//

PETALING JAYA: Long before the Hong Kong movie Ip Man made the Wing Chun form of kung fu famous, the son of a silat master here has been practising the traditional Chinese martial arts for years.

Kahar Zaitun, 36, started learning the fight form since 1991 after completing his secondary school education.

He credits sifu Yip Fook Choy for breaking the stereotype and taking him as student. He said many other kung fu masters had refused him prior to that.

“My father told me that if I were to learn martial arts, I will have to also master Wing Chun as it is the most comprehensive of all exercises,” said Kahar who found Yip via a telephone directory.

“He is a very famous Wing Chun master,” said Kahar. “From that day onwards, he became my other father and I call him sifu.

“Sifu is a very open-minded person. Race was never a consideration for him,” he added.

The Nottingham Trent University mechanical engineering graduate continues to be an avid Wing Chun follower until today.

Kahar, a translator with Perodua, became Yip’s assistant coach in 2001 and now helps train about 50 students here, in Kuantan, and Kuala Lumpur.

“There are still people who are shocked to see a Malay instructor teaching kung fu,” said Kahar. “Many people, especially the Chinese, do not believe that I know Wing Chun until they see me coach,” he said.

Kahar, a father of a three-year-old son, said Wing Chun had shaped his character and his entire life. Yip, 67, said Kahar was one of his most faithful students throughout his 60-odd years of teaching martial arts.

“Even though he is from a different race, he truly respects me as his sifu,” he said.

“I do not treat him differently. I just accept him for who he is and teach him all that I know.”

More than 10% economic expansion in first quarter for the first time in 10 years

**KUALA LUMPUR:** The country's economy is likely to register growth of more than 10% in the first three months of the year – an achievement not seen in the last 10 years.

The latest economic indicators show a positive trend. Exports in March grew by 36.4% beating the market forecast of 22.4%. Imports rose by 45.3% (forecasts were around 30%).

The London-based Financial Times says: "Given Malaysia's high exposure to trade, the numbers bode well for first quarter gross domestic product growth".

Analysts from major banks, local and international, put the first three months' growth at between 9.8% and 12% and they expect the trend to continue for the second quarter making it a "very good first half of the year for Malaysia."

As a result, the analysts are also revising upwards their estimates for Malaysia's GDP growth forecast for the year. Banks are now forecasting the annual GDP to grow by between 8% and 11% as compared to Bank Negara's earlier estimate of between 4.5% and 5%.

"Given the recent developments in both domestic and external conditions, we are confident our 2010 forecast of 8% should be achievable," said Ambank group chief economist Manokaran Mottain in his Economic update released here yesterday.

He also noted that besides the surge in exports, there was a marked improvement in private sector spending, especially by households. Big ticket items such as cars have seen increased sales.

According to the Malaysian Automotive Association, auto sales surged 25% year-on-year in March to 56,139 units, up from 44,896 in the same month last year.

HSBC Global Research economist Robert Prior-Wandesforde in his report entitled "From bust to boom - double-digit GDP growth in Singapore and Malaysia?" noted that the recovery of the economy came three months faster than expected.

While the Financial Times said, "Malaysia is roaring out of recession even faster than expected".

The country's key economic indicators including the export figures were released on Tuesday.

Malaysia's exports recorded a new high for the month of March, amounting to RM59.44bil, registering a significant growth of 36.4% year-on-year. This was also the highest post-crisis monthly exports recorded since September 2008. Imports rose 45.3% to RM45.09bil.

The increase in exports was largely contributed by increases in exports of electrical and electronic (E&E) products, which surged 31.8%; chemicals and chemical products, (+60.8%); palm oil, (+49.3%); transport equipment, (+188.4%); as well as crude petroleum (+55.8%).

COMMENT:

The analysis shows that Malaysia can register growth of more than 10% in the first three months of the year – an achievement not seen in the last 10 years. The figures indicate that Malaysia is booming out of recession. In order to sustain such growth, energy efficiency is crucial so that the cost of energy does not burden and increase the utility cost of the suppliers and manufacturers so that they can compete efficiently and economically in the world map.

Better to get half than have the oil sitting on the sea bed for another 50 yrs of haggling. Look at the interest loss, opportunity cost and inflation cost of 50 yrs idle oil. Even after ICJ decision it is

not assured we will have peaceful possession if Brunei dissatisfied (like BN and Perak)

.....TITLE OR BENEFITS

If Brunei can dispute Limbang after losing sovereignty 100yrs, why are we alarmed over effectively a production sharing agreement? Ceding sovereignty is perhaps a legal convenience to begin exploration or else who to sign agreements?

The sovereignty is worth only oil and gas, passage and sea water. First two, Pak Lah got something for M'sia. Oil and gas matter is not total loss (which is a possibility under arbitration), passage is guaranteed.

Only the sea was ceded totally. Maybe he lost some sea water for M'sia! Do we want the title deed badly for sake of it or we can't lose sea water? Sea water a vital heritage? Better to share than lock horns into a stalemate. We got sovereign access without sovereignty.

Misleading and malintention to insinuate Pak Lah signed away absolute rights, lock stock and barrel.

.....LIMBANG CLAIM

Brunei technically right on Limbang 'claim' as border not demarcated yet, only principles agreed. But we know the principles if followed marks Limbang within M'sian borders. Brunei's claim after that is like Phillipines in claiming Sabah. Are you worried for Sabah?

.....THE GAINS

Losing some sea water and getting share in oil and gas in exchange for tourism, timber, agricultural land and loyal pop of 47000 in Limbang is not sell out.

Example of sell out is highway concessions. We give land, loans, subsidy, pay escalating tolls and still have to compensate them? Getting part share and settling border dispute to build friendly relations with neighbour is quid pro quo not surrender.

Quid pro quo bad? Example of quid pro quo is hand over premiership to Pak Lah with promise not to disrupt mega projects. Cronyism, patronage, nepotism are manifestations of quid pro quo. Signing away 4 DPMS, signing rules challenging presidency, sign out Royal assent are far easier than signing agreements with a sovereign Sultan.

Govt gives go-ahead for nuclear power plant by 2021

By LESTER KONG

KUALA LUMPUR: The Government has approved the setting up of a nuclear power plant, slated to start operating from 2021.

Energy, Green Technology and Water Minister Datuk Seri Peter Chin Fah Kui said his ministry has been given the go-ahead by the Economic Council to start identifying suitable sites.

Declining to reveal the possible sites and the total power deliverable, Chin said the nuclear plant needed to be built in an area with high power demand.

"Building of the first plant needs a lead time of at least 10 years.

"We need to look at the safety aspects, human resources and the location," he said, adding that the International Atomic Energy Agency had the final say on whether the plant could be built.

Technology know-how and providers may possibly come from South Korea, China, France or Japan, he added.

He stressed that a nuclear plant was sorely needed to meet the country's accelerating energy needs and ensured its energy security.

"Nuclear energy is the only viable option toward our long term energy needs.

"Our energy mix is rather unhealthy. We are depending too much on coal and oil," he told reporters after launching the first Carbon Neutral Conference on Sustainable Buildings South East Asia on Tuesday.

Chin stressed that despite nuclear energy's astronomical start-up costs, it was more cost- and energy-efficient than dotting the country with coal-fired power plants.

On the political fallout from building a nuclear plant, Chin said the Government would be ready to explain to the people the need for one.

He added that the Government would not approve a project that was not good for the country.//

Dear Tun Dr Mahathir,

We refer to your statements regarding the surrender of 2 blocks of oil producing offshore areas called Block L and Block M in the territorial waters of Sarawak Malaysia to Brunei "in return for Limbang in Sarawak". Tun had written that Block L and Block M had been claimed by Malaysia based on historical facts. The two blocks were awarded to Petronas Carigali Sdn Bhd in 2003 , which entered into a production sharing contract with Murphy Oil Corporation to start drilling.

The crude oil reserves were estimated at almost 1 billion barrels, and that the former Prime Minister Tun Abdullah Badawi, who signed the "surrender" has caused Malaysia to lose at least USD100billion (about RM320 billion) of Malaysia's oil in this agreement.

Tun had claimed that when Abdullah negotiated with Sultan of Brunei Sultan Hassanal Bolkiah, no Petronas representatives were present, only foreign office staff and the Foreign Affairs adviser to the Prime Minister were present. You have called for Wisma Putra to explain why it did not stop Abdullah. A Wisma Putra spokesman said they are still investigating the matter.

Democratic Action Party adviser Lim Kit Siang has on April 30th, also called on the former prime minister Abdullah to explain on the matter.

Abdullah in his statement published amongst others on front page of The Borneo Post of May 1st and the Star of the same date, titled "Cabinet approved, I signed-Pak Lah" in the Borneo Post, and "Pak Lah denies ceding oil rights" in the latter paper refutes the claims that the Exchange of

Letters between him and Sultan of Brunei was a deal with Brunei in 'exchange' for Limbang. He further denied that he signed away Malaysia's rights to potential oil revenue in the South China Sea to Brunei. Interestingly, the Star also gave a location map of Blocks L and M., which is within the Sarawak continental shelf.

According to Abdullah's statement in the Borneo Post, "the former prime minister confirmed that Block L and Block M concessions now belonged to Brunei but the agreement provided that Malaysia would be allowed to participate in joint development of oil and gas in the two areas for a period of 40 years. The financial and operational modalities for giving effect to this arrangement will be further discussed by the two sides. This means that in so far as the oil and gas resources are concerned, the agreement is not a loss for Malaysia."

The same report stated that Abdullah signed the agreements on March 15 and 16 last year, two weeks before he stepped down as prime minister on April 13.

The week before US-based Murphy Oil Corp stated that Malaysia's Petronas had terminated the production sharing contracts for Blocks L and M as they "are no longer part of Malaysia."

Tun, based on your statements and the clarifications by Abdullah, there are nonetheless, several other critical unresolved issues which must be answered urgently as these involve national and Sarawak state sovereign rights over Blocks L and M, as well as all other areas onland and offshore whereby petroleum rights have been transferred to Petronas by Sarawak and other Malaysian states, and the constitutional position regarding surrender of national or state territory to another country.

Our concerns as citizens of this Nation are as follows:-

(1) Article 2 (b) of the Malaysian Federal Constitution stipulates that "Parliament may ... (b) alter the boundaries of any State, but a law altering the boundaries of a State altering the boundaries of a State shall not be passed without the consent of that State (expressed by a law made by the Legislature of that State) and of the Conference of Rulers." The Federal Constitution thus clearly states that any surrender of any sovereign territory of any State must be passed in the State Assembly of the relevant State, and endorsed by the Federal Parliament and the Conference of Rulers. How does Abdullah reconcile these irregularities, and therefore, what is the legal position of the Exchange of Letters transferring sovereign rights over Blocks L and M to Brunei only with Federal Cabinet sovereignty over Blocks L and M based on Federal Cabinet decision?

(2) Under the Petroleum Development Act of 1974 does transfer of rights for the development of petroleum amount to surrendering to Petronas and Federal Government those territories with potential oil and gas reserves? Surrender of Blocks L and M to Brunei would appear to give this right to Federal Government over State sovereign territorial rights? If this precedent is going to be accepted as foregone conclusion by Malaysians, what is to stop future Prime Ministers giving away more territories currently under Petronas "jurisdiction" over some pretext, and what fate

would await petroleum producing States?

(3) From Abdullah's statement he confirmed giving away the two blocks to Brunei, but that Petronas would be allowed to participate in joint development of the petroleum reserves for 40 years subject to "the financial and operational modalities ... to be further discussed...." Even assuming the issues raised in (1), (2) and (3) above are non-existent, what kind of negotiation was our former prime minister and foreign minister conducting, when you give up your trump card, and then pray that the other Party would give you a fair deal? Did we lose a war, that we must see the Sultan of Brunei to surrender our rights over Blocks L and M, which in terms of size is bigger than Brunei? In fact in the statement Abdullah and Rais made immediately after the signing of the Exchange of Letters, they gave the impression that the land border issue with Limbang was basically resolved with the agreement, but this was quickly denied by Brunei. Another blunder, as Brunei receive Blocks L and M on the cheap and yet maintain its claims over Limbang!

(4) For a subject matter of such national importance and huge commercial value, why was Abdullah in such a hurry to sign off with the Sultan of Brunei ie just two weeks before retiring? Guz Dur, a former president of Indonesia faced scandal on "donation" by Sultan of Brunei over some smaller issue. Is there a cause for concern here?

(5) For Sarawak, apart from the loss of territorial waters, the potential financial loss in terms of royalty at 5% as per agreement with Petronas, based on Tun's figure of at least USD100billion, is USD5billion or RM16billion. If it is assumed that joint development with Brunei could actually materialize, at say 50-50 production sharing, the loss of royalty to Sarawak would be USD2.5billion or RM8billion, and to Malaysia USD50billion or RM160billion, a massive waste of potential revenue. The total silence of the State leaders on the loss of part of the State's territorial waters, as well as potential revenue for the State is deafening and needs clarification.

In the light of grave ramifications, as tabulated above from the action of the former Prime minister Abdullah, and the direct involvement of the then Minister of Foreign Affairs in the discussions, we are of the view that it is not appropriate for Wisma Putra to investigate into these national blunders due to direct conflict of interest. The most appropriate body to do so should be a non-partisan Royal Commission of Enquiry to be appointed by Parliament, as well as MACC.

We hope that the current Prime Minister who preaches clean and transparent Government would speedily respond on the need to appoint a Royal Commission of Enquiry and MACC to investigate into this matter. All patriotic Malaysians should also speak out on this subject as it involves the loss of part of our national territory, and future income which could benefit our children.

5) Urusniaga "Crude Oil" ini bukan diantara "end user dan seller". Peringkat awalan perundingan dijalankan oleh "broker" yang dilantik pihak seller ( Petronas ) dan "broker" yang dilantik buyer/end user. Sekiranya satu2 urusniaga contohnya Petronas nak jual 50,000 barrel per day, akan dilantiklah "broker" oleh Petronas yang 'diarah' PPM untuk mewakili Petronas jual kepada "end-user". Untuk pengetahuan Tun minyak mentah hanya boleh dijual kepada "end-user" sahaja.
