

TURKEY TO SELL GASOLINE TO IRAN DESPITE SANCTIONS

1. America has a strong grudge against Iran ever since the Islamic revolution when personnel in the United States' embassy were incarcerated in Iranian jails for a very long period. Attempts to rescue them failed miserably when helicopters carrying a special force crashed.

3. As usual the US resorted to economic sanctions. Reserves belonging to Iran held in America were frozen.

5. Although Iran has a lot of oil, it does not have adequate refining capacity. It needs to import gasoline and Turkey has been one of the suppliers. Malaysia too has been supplying gasoline to Iran.
6. America would very much like to invade Iran and engineer a regime change. But America's experiences in Afghanistan and Iraq have shown that military invasion is not only extremely costly but will cause America to be stuck in endless war. So America is trying to do it on the cheap by strangling Iran economically.
7. America has been known to tell lies in order to launch attacks against weak countries. The stories about Iran being about to produce nuclear weapons are no different from the stories about Iraq's weapons of mass destruction. They are invented to get the world to support America's revenge against Iran.
8. Even the simple-minded must know that America has more than 10,000 nuclear warheads. Should any small country use nuclear weapons the Americans would not hesitate to erase that country from the world map with the nuclear weapons in America's arsenal. I don't think the Iranian leaders are so dumb that they would take this risk.
9. But the story that it might can convince the world that Iran is a threat and it must be strangled through sanctions so that it would not be able to develop such weapons. innocent people of Iran. It is heartening to note that Turkey has now decided not to kill Iranians by lifting the ban on the export of gasoline to Iran.

Critical for Malaysia to regain competitive edge

2. PETALING JAYA: As Malaysia goes into overdrive to promote private investments, the trend towards further liberalisation, ease of doing business, minimal red tape and bureaucracy, and greater transparency is inevitable.

3. It is critical for the country to have these elements in place to regain its competitive edge and become an attractive investment destination for both domestic and foreign businesses.

4. "At present, internal constraints policy-wise and an inefficient bureaucracy, as well as structural weaknesses such as the lack of skilled and knowledge workers, are impeding Malaysia's ability to compete with emerging economies, especially 1) China, 2) India, 3) Indonesia and 4) Vietnam, for foreign direct investments (FDIs)," said an economist. "Those limitations are also posing a challenge for the economy in terms of attracting and retaining domestic resources for local investments," he added.

5. Under the Government's economic transformation programme, boosting private investments have become central to achieving an annual gross domestic product growth target of at least 6% for the next 10 years so that the country can become a developed and high-income economy by 2020.

6. Various initiatives have been put in place to raise the growth of private investments, from a meagre 2% increase per annum between 2006 and 2009 under the Ninth Malaysia Plan (9MP), to 12.8% per annum, or a total of RM115bil a year, from 2011 to 2015 under the 10MP.

7. The 10MP has identified 12 national key economic areas (NKEAs) – 1) oil, gas and energy; 2) financial services; 3) wholesale and retail; 4) palm oil; 5) tourism; 6) electrical and electronics; 7) business services; 8) communications, 9) content and infrastructure; 10) education; 11) agriculture; and 12) healthcare as well as the Greater Kuala Lumpur urban revitalisation programme – to attract the interest of both domestic and foreign investors.

8. Boosting private investments

9. According to the Performance and Delivery Unit (Pemandu), 131 projects – also referred to as entry point projects (EPPs) – have been identified and would be launched over the next five years to stimulate private investments.

10. These projects are expected to create up to 3.3 million new jobs, most of which are in the middle to high-income segments, over the next 10 years.

11. The EPPs would be 92% funded by the private sector, while public funding would be limited to only 8%. About 80% of the projects would involve domestic investments, while the remainder would come from FDIs.

12. An economist said the private sector has to be the driver of sustainable growth as the Government had limited capacity given its rising budget deficit.

13. He said the country's huge savings-investment gap over the years was proof that there was ample domestic private resources that could be mobilised to stimulate the country's economy.
14. "The next 10 years will, hopefully, mark a different era for the country, whereby we will see the private sector taking the lead role in growing the economy," the economist said.
15. Kenanga Investment Bank economist Wan Suhaimie Saidi concurred, but with reservations. He said "implementation is key; otherwise it will be tough to achieve our targets."
16. "Setting targets and having plans are good and it speaks clearly of our intention to be on the right track to achieving higher growth. But whether we can move fast enough and execute those plans to stimulate the private sector is a different matter altogether."
17. TA Research economist Patricia Oh said she was confident that the recovery of the global and domestic economy, as well as the implementation of government and economic transformation programmes, would drive private investments in Malaysia over the longer term.
18. "We should see some strong recovery for private investments from this year onwards," she said, citing a recent report by the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development's (UNCTAD) on the recovery of global FDI flows.
19. According to UNCTAD, global FDI flows would exceed US\$1.2 trillion (RM3.76 trillion) this year, up from US\$1.1 trillion last year.
20. This would be followed by an increase of global FDI flows to around US\$1.3 trillion to US\$1.5 trillion next year, and to US\$1.6 trillion to US\$2 trillion in 2012.
21. Wan Suhaimie said it was necessary for Malaysia to be "radical in our approach to differentiate ourselves from the rest of the pack" in competing for FDIs.
22. "Other governments are also putting in effort to improve the investment climate in their own countries to compete for global FDI flows," he said.
23. Malaysia has become more selective of the types of foreign investments it wants to attract. But economists said the country needs to have the talent to attract high-value, capital and knowledge intensive industries that it is eyeing.
24. "We need to get this aspect in order, either through attracting foreign expertise or drawing overseas Malaysian experts back to the country through Talent Corp," said an economist.

3. THE message has been made loud and clear – there will be zero tolerance for racism. No rational and reasonable Malaysia would argue against this in the wake of racist remarks made by bigoted Malaysians.

4. We are used to bankrupt politicians uttering hurtful words about other communities in the belief that they can win votes by projecting themselves as racist supremacists and, by extension, as protectors of their race.
5. But this sickening action seems to have grown, with more racial champions being given bigger space in the media, which would only encourage them further.
6. Frankly, some of these figures, who now also include obscure academics, have been created by the media. Without this platform, they would otherwise be just nobodies. In fact, most Malaysians would prefer for them to stay that way as their actions have created ill feelings and polarisation.
7. Their racially warped writings and statements, which may seem supportive of the government, have not helped the ruling party.
8. They may like to think that they are doing the national leaders a service, but the truth is they are held in disgust and contempt by most Malaysians. They have, in fact, inflicted serious damage to the government.
9. The media, both mainstream and alternative, should downplay their racist statements: better still, spike it – or delete it, as the modern journalist would say.
10. After 53 years of independence, Malaysian politicians and community leaders, by right, should be more confident, outward looking and politically mature but the perception is that we have gone downhill.
11. The ugly side, or more aptly the darker side, of some politicians seems to have emerged, which must be one of the dampeners to the National Day celebrations.
12. How can we remain indifferent when politicians, people we used to hold with high regard, suddenly start to beat the racial drum instead of passing the pipe of peace around?
13. What has shaken many Malaysians is that the appalling actions of some of these racists seem to have garnered a following.
14. Otherwise, how does one explain reports of Perkasa expressing support for the headmistress from Johor who purportedly made racist remarks or the outpouring of support for her in her Facebook page?
15. Most of us have been brought up by our parents to believe that there can be only be right or wrong. They also taught us that there are only good and bad people.
16. But there are also the ugly people now. Racism in whatever form is sickening. We have all experienced it in one form or another.
17. None of these experiences were pleasant, even if they seemed minor and were not worth getting upset about.
18. But we need to stand up at some point and say that we cannot tolerate racism and will not allow politicians to get away with statements which cause unhappiness.
19. Neither should the government be seen to be dragging its feet when taking action against people such as the headmistress. Why in the world do we need a task force to investigate the simple case of a headmistress? It's either she did it or she didn't.
20. If she didn't, and that the issue has been hyped up unnecessarily, let her enjoy her holidays in peace. If she is guilty, then act against her. Let's get this case over and done with so the nation can move on.
21. The Education Ministry must also issue notices to all schools to stress that racist statements cannot be accepted nor tolerated and that action, including expulsion of students, would be carried out if anyone is found violating these rules.

22. This is a normal practice in many British schools and we should adopt this disciplinary code if we are committed to zero tolerance. It will be a mockery to have the 1Malaysian slogan painted on the school walls if the teachers or students within do not practise it.

23. We must be brave enough to confront racist bullies. We must be ready to tell those who claim to champion the cause of our community that their myopic line will not benefit Malaysia.

24. It is when some of us remain silent that we unwittingly allow these self-appointed community leaders to hijack our national goals. We must realise that by choosing to close an eye, we may well give the impression that we are silent racists.

2. PAS leader Datuk Nik Aziz Nik Mat won brownie points among the non-Malays for his defence of Teo Nie Ching's faux pax in a Selangor surau. But compromising on such issues may have lost his party ground among the Malays.

3. SERDANG MP Teo Nie Ching rushed to the High Court on Monday morning in the hope of meeting Datuk Nik Abdul Aziz Nik Mat who was there for the Kelantan government's suit against Petronas.

4. But when she got there, she was told the Kelantan Menteri Besar was about to leave for the mosque to perform sembahyang hajat or special prayers.

5. Teo was advised to go and wait at Kelantan House where Nik Aziz puts up when he is in Kuala Lumpur. Her persistence paid off and she met Nik Aziz for about 15 minutes over what some have called her political baptism of fire.

6. There had been an uproar when a photograph of the petite and pretty DAP politician making a speech in the Surau Al-Huda in Kajang appeared on the front page of a leading Malay newspaper.

7. The photograph showed her speaking into a microphone in the dewan solat or prayer court of the surau (No-no Number 1); her head was uncovered (No-no Number 2); and she was wearing a form fitting baju kebaya or what some have labelled an “SIA stewardess uniform” (No-no Number 3).

8. DAP leaders slammed the news report as “Umno-instigated” and accused the paper of blowing the issue out of proportion.

9. But behind the scenes, they knew the reaction among Muslims out there was not entirely about politics and they were concerned about how to handle the fallout.

10. Teo had crossed the line and this became all too clear when word came from the state government that the Sultan of Selangor, the Islamic head in the state, was upset about the matter.

11. From that point, the DAP defence that Teo had not done anything wrong ground to a stop and she was advised to apologise to the Sultan. Her letter of apology was handed to the Sultan by the Selangor Mentri Besar a few days later.

12. DAP leaders also approached their PAS colleagues for advice and that was when it was suggested that Teo should try to meet Nik Aziz.

13. The tvpas.com video of the meeting showed Nik Aziz doing most of the talking while Teo did all the nodding.

14. Teo is a practising lawyer, a vivacious speaker and fluent in Bahasa Malaysia. The novice politician made a huge impact in the last elections because she was such a natural and confident speaker.

15. But she has been under a lot of pressure in the last couple of weeks and seemed overwhelmed by Nik Aziz and was virtually sitting on the edge of the white sofa, her hands clasped on her lap.

16. Officially, the purpose of meeting Nik Aziz was for Teo to seek advice but the real aim was to signal to the Malay ground that Teo had been “absolved” of the faux pax by the Tok Guru.

17. “This is too much and in the holiest month for the Muslims. She ran to Nik Aziz because she wanted a political solution. If she really wanted religious advice, she should have gone to the mufti,” said pro-Umno blogger Zakhir Mohamed.

18. Teo has since resumed her Ramadan duties in more demure fashion, opting for the modest baju kurung and a variety of shawls for events at the surau or mosque.

19. PKR’s William Leong, the Selayang MP, also came under fire following reports in the same Malay daily that he had given a tazkirah or religious talk at the Masjid at-Fakwa.

20. Leong has been rather level-headed about the whole incident.

21. “I wouldn’t know how to give a tazkirah even if I wanted to. Besides, it is not as though I barged in and grabbed the mike. I was invited by the mosque committee,” he said.

22. But Leong probably came under less pressure because he is a man and a lot of activities revolving around the mosque are run by men.

23. A corporate lawyer, Leong’s experience of Ramadan before going into politics was breaking fast with his corporate clients in hotels. It has been a sharp learning curve and he now finds himself making donations to orphans, single mothers and the poor.

24. Actually, the relationship between politicians and mosques is an old story. Over the years religion has given politics and politicians a legitimacy that they would otherwise not enjoy among a large segment of Muslims and Malays and no other parties play it as intensely as Umno and PAS.

25. But non-Muslims making speeches in the prayer court is something else, hence the unequivocal response from the Selangor Sultan whose opinion about keeping the mosque and surau free of partisan politics is well known.

26. On Wednesday, the Selangor palace issued an order stating that non-Muslims are not permitted to enter the prayer court of mosques or surau without permission from the Selangor Islamic Religious Council (Mais).

27. Selangor is also touchy about politicians speaking in the mosque, no matter how well-versed they may be in their religious knowledge.

28. Earlier last month, when opening a religious primary school in the state, the Sultan had urged Muslims to step up efforts to overcome problems that posed a challenge to the institution of Islam. Among these challenges were the use of the word "Allah" by non-Muslims, deviant teaching, misuse of mosques and social issues affecting young Muslims.

29. Clear signals on transgressions

30. The Raja Muda of Perak, Raja Dr Nazrin Shah, in a speech in Ipoh a few days after the incident, cautioned that "major transgressions in Islam begin from small acts" and that it could start from a surau, madrasah or masjid, or from a speech, khutbah, tazkirah or doa. There was no mistaking what he was referring to.

31. The two royals are sending clear signals on where they stand on religious matters.

32. There is no denying that reports on the Teo and Leong incidents were somewhat exaggerated especially the allegations that they had delivered tazkirah. If Teo was not even aware of how women ought to dress in religious settings, she could hardly be capable of a tazkirah.

33. At the same time, politicians like them are challenging stereotypical perceptions of the role of elected representatives. The new breed wants to be YBs for all races and that is something for everyone to think about in the new political landscape.

34. Several leading ulama such as Perak mufti Tan Sri Harussani Zakaria and Johor religious advisor Datuk Nooh Gadot jumped into the fray but most Malay politicians steered clear of it.

35. No Malay politician worth his salt wants to mess around with the palace and most have been in the game long enough to know the specifics of mosque etiquette.

36. PAS president Datuk Seri Hadi Awang, for one, was mum throughout. His silence was read as disapproval of what had happened. Party insiders said opinion on the matter had been divided at the PAS central working committee meeting last Sunday night.

37. But PAS intellectual and Kuala Selangor MP Dr Dzulkifly Ahmad said: "There is a great divide given the emerging two-party system taking place. The one willing to be in touch with the changing political landscape will be the one who will survive the new political contestation. It does not pay to take a jaundiced view of religion."

38. Nevertheless, not everyone in PAS is happy with Nik Aziz's stand. They say his political side seems to be dominating the ulama in him these days.

39. He had gone out of his way to defend DAP on the cancellation of the Malidur Rasul procession in Penang and the incident where Perak DAP leader Nga Kor Ming mispronounced Koranic verses.

40. More recently, there was the furore over the khutbah in Penang during which the imam neglected to pray for the Agong who is the head of Islam in the country but mentioned the Chief Minister's name instead.

41. The debate among ordinary Muslims has generally not been sympathetic to Teo's blunder. There are those who are clearly angry and feel she had not shown respect to their religious norms.

42. The more reasonable excuse her attire to ignorance but say she had transgressed certain boundaries by entering the prayer court.

43. "Mosques should be opened to non-Muslims but not the dewan solat and not in that kind of outfit. I'm not comfortable with that," said one young Malay lawyer.

44. It is quite clear that DAP leaders work well with the consummate politician that Nik Aziz is.

45. He has become some sort of Band-Aid to the DAP when they stumble, fall and scrape their knee. To put it more bluntly, some think he has become an apologist for the DAP.

46. Those in Pakatan Rakyat call it coalition politics – that parties should help each other.

47. Nik Aziz won brownie points among the non-Malays but it is doubtful if he has won any ground among the Muslims on this issue.

48. The fasting month is a time for prayer, reflection and good deeds and Malay politicians often try to downplay politics during this special time.

49. But, said the well-known and controversial blogger Syed Azidi Syed Abdul Aziz also known as Kickdefella: "One political incident after another, this is a highly political Ramadan."
