

## **THE NEP**

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**August 12, 2011**

1. Tan Sri Ramon Navaratnam is vehement that the New Economic Policy is the cause of poor inflow of Foreign Direct Investments here.

2. One can fault the NEP for a lot of things but to blame it for the current slowdown in Foreign Direct Investments is not quite correct.

3. There are of course some investors who were and are put off by the NEP and the abuses involving it. But FDI actually contributed much to Malaysia's industrialisation. And this happened when the NEP was in full swing, in fact picked up during the time when the NEP was being implemented.

4. Between 1986 to 1997, Malaysia attained the highest growth rates with FDI contributing much towards this achievement.

5. The FDI began to slow down only when China and Vietnam opened themselves to foreign investments. As the cost of labour in Malaysia rose, the countries with much lower cost of labour such as Indonesia and Thailand began to attract more foreign investment. All these affected the flow of foreign investments into Malaysia.

6. Today foreign investments have decreased because of the financial problems faced by the developed countries.

7. Blaming the NEP is political. That is all there is to it.

8. That "the majority would argue that the (NEP) policy is the source of all problems facing the nation" as quoted by Dr Muhammed Abdul Khalid here, does not mean that he agrees with the said majority.

9. Therefore he was correct in saying that Tan Sri Ramon Navaratnam was "factually incorrect".

10. Let us resurrect at the figures of FDI before NEP, and during the years the NEP was being implemented and compare them with those of neighbouring countries. We should also look at the economic growth figures of Malaysia since the NEP was implemented and compare with the period before NEP.

11. These figures would validate or disprove the claims of Tan Sri Ramon Navaratnam and the majority that the NEP was at the root of all the problems in Malaysia.

12. Finally Malaysia was able to tackle the depression caused by the devaluation of its currency by currency traders without the social problems as witnessed in other countries affected by the Asian Financial Crisis of 1997-98 and thereafter. Indeed it was the partial success of the NEP in correcting the disparities between the races in Malaysia that the racial problems seen in neighbouring countries did not plague the nation.

So, with a decade more of NEP to come, Bumiputeras will not be able to stay in or ahead of other races.

Next, the effectiveness of the NEP. Policies were drawn broad and wide to assist all walks of life of the Bumiputera. Whether the folks are into SMEs or large corporations, it is there to provide assistance to catapult them into an economic entity.

Don't you ever find that NEP has failed to educate the large number of Malay muslims with strong and accurate knowledge about Islam and failed to inculcate them with some moderate thinking about the importance of religious tolerances? Many a time we find that some emotional muslims who only have acquired some half-past-six knowledge about Islam will quickly rise up to protest a government measure on regulating religious

practices for the sake of the public in general. (The most recent protest incident happened in Penang when the Penang State Government attempts to regulate the volume of "Azan" from a mosque in early morning.) While the Quranic principle requires all muslims to observe their faith by saying "solat" (obligatory prayers) five times in a day, all muslims are also required to say prayers in a proper manner. One example of the improper manner which can validate the prayer is as follows:

Intending in the heart to interrupt the prayer. Intending to interrupt it if a specific matter happens, such as if one holds: "if the other Islamic folks did not rise up from their bed to say dawn prayer as me, I will interrupt my prayer and turn on my speaker loud in order to wake them up", invalidates the prayer immediately.

The Quranic principle also requires that all Muslims have to show compassion on others, including the sick persons, the kids (whether muslim or non-muslim) and other non-muslim adults who need to have adequate sleep before they start a new day's hard work in order to earn a living. Therefore, it is only proper for a decent muslim to control the volume of his saying prayer without using a loud speaker in the dawn because Allah will never need a speaker or amplifier in order to listen to the prayers. For your information, the Islamic Authority of the Perlis State has already regulated the volume of "Azan" during the dawn prayers since 30.04.2007.
