Saya akui saya ada mencadangkan agar berlaku lebih banyak lagi IPO GLC ke Bursa sebab saya lihat ada permintaan tinggi untuk saham-saham GLC. Contohnya Petronas Chemical Group (PCG) dimana walaupun ianya adalah IPO terbesar dalam sejarah Malaysia, tetapi permohonan membeli saham tersebut telah oversubscribe sebanyak 20 kali ganda.

Melalui IPO, saham dipindahkan dari kerajaan kepada swasta. Dengan ini, kerajaan akan dapat hasil daripada penjualan IPO tersebut disamping tidak lagi dibebani kos menguruskan GLC tersebut. GLC tersebut diharap dapat beroperasi dengan lebih efisien dan meningkatkan keuntungan di mana kerajaan sekali lagi mendapat hasil apabila keuntungan meningkat daripada kutipan cukai.

Jika saham-saham milik Khazanah sebenarnya milik kaum bumiputra, maka kerajaan perlu melakukan sesuatu agar hak bumiputra terpelihara. Mungkin daripada membuat penjualan, saham-saham baru dikeluarkan untuk IPO tersebut. Saham-saham baru perlu ada peruntukan untuk bumiputra untuk memastikan bumiputra juga dapat manfaat dari IPO tersebut. Kerajaan juga perlu memastikan ada 'golden share' dalam GLC tersebut agar kepentingan bumiputra dalam GLC tersebut sentiasa terpelihara.

Yang Amat Berbahagia Tun,

Semoga sentiasa berada dalam keadaan sihat sejahtera.

1. Setiap Perdana Menteri di negara ini akan diuji dengan perarakan seperti Bersih 2.0, terutamanya pada dua penggal pertama beliau menyandang jawatan tersebut. Tindakan yang beliau ambil akan menentukan sama ada beliau benar-benar boleh membawa negara ke arah kemajuan dan keamanan.

2. Keputusan beberapa NGO termasuk Pemuda UMNO sendiri untuk mengadakan perarakan balas menunjukkan bahawa ramai yang mula beranggapan bahawa kerajaan tidak mampu menangani golongan 'the aggressive minority'.

3. Golongan ini selalu menggunakan perkataan 'rakyat'. Sebenarnya, tidak ramai penduduk negara ini yang berpendirian sama seperti mereka. Bahkan sejumlah besar mungkin tidak bersetuju dengan apa yang mereka laungkan. Penggunaan perkataan 'rakyat' dalam tuntutan-tuntutan mereka adalah sesuatu yang mengelirukan. Dalam membuat rundingan, kerajaan perlu berhati-hati. Kerajaan perlu memeriksa sama ada tuntutan-tuntutan tersebut disokong oleh majoriti penduduk negara ini.

Tuntutan Rakyat

4. Kebelakangan ini, kita mendengar banyak tuntutan dibuat terhadap kerajaan. Golongan yang membuat tuntutan ini mendakwa bahawa sekarang adalah zaman kebangkitan rakyat.

Rakyat kini sedar akan hak mereka dan apa yang mereka tuntut wajib dipenuhi.

5. Terdapat lebih 27 juta penduduk di negara ini. Setiap orang yang mempunyai kad pengenalan akan mengakui bahawa dirinya adalah rakyat Malaysia.

6. Kerajaan tidak akan mampu memenuhi kehendak atau tuntutan setiap rakyat Malaysia. Begitu juga di negara maju, tidak semua tuntutan dapat dipenuhi.

7. Untuk mengatasi masalah ini, satu sistem yang digelar demokrasi digunakan. Dalam demokrasi, rakyat bebas bersuara tetapi suara yang datangnya daripada ramai pihak akan diutamakan.

8. Kita dapat melihat bagaimana pincangnya dasar yang dibuat apabila kerajaan mendengar suara daripada pihak tertentu sahaja.

Pinjaman Perumahan

9. Pinjaman perumahan yang dinaikkan kepada 105% hanya akan menguntungkan institusi kewangan dan pemaju perumahan sahaja. Pihak bank akan mengaut keuntungan yang lebih banyak manakala pemaju perumahan pula boleh menjual rumah dengan harga yang tinggi.

10. Orang yang berpendapatan sederhana dan rendah perlu berhati-hati membuat pinjaman ini. Mereka perlu ingat bahawa mereka akan dibebani jumlah hutang yang tinggi disamping tempoh hutang yang lama. Mereka sebenarnya akan lebih banyak kehilangan kuasa membeli.

11. Apabila ramai yang hidup berhutang dan kurang kuasa membeli, negara tidak akan mencapai keadaan ekonomi yang kukuh. Ekonomi boleh berkembang tetapi ia tidak akan kukuh.

12. Sekiranya sesuatu krisis kewangan berlaku, negara akan mengalami kejatuhan ekonomi yang ketara. Inilah yang berlaku di Amerika Syarikat. Ramai rakyatnya yang berhutang. Mereka tidak mempunyai kuasa membeli mutlak.

13. Malaysia tidak perlu mengikut jejak langkah tersebut.

14. Adalah baik jika kerajaan mengambil pendekatan untuk meningkatkan kuasa membeli rakyat. Dengan mengawal kenaikan harga rumah yang mendadak, kuasa membeli rakyat dapat dipertingkatkan.

15. Malangnya, Akta Persaingan yang akan berkuatkuasa pada 2012 tidak meliputi sektor perumahan. Pemaju masih boleh berpakat (melalui cartel) menentukan harga rumah. Kita akan terus melihat persatuan pemaju perumahan mengumumkan kenaikan tahunan harga rumah di kaca televisyen.

Pelupusan Syarikat Berkaitan Kerajaan

16. Pelupusan syarikat berkaitan kerajaan merupakan hasil cadangan daripada beberapa pihak. Mereka kebanyakannya adalah pemain industri.

17. Dalam memberikan cadangan, mereka mengambil kira peluang yang akan diperolehi apabila cadangan itu dilaksanakan kelak. Majoriti rakyat yang juga pengguna nampaknya kurang memberikan cadangan, ataupun suara mereka sayup-sayup sahaja.

18. Banyak syarikat berkaitan kerajaan berada dalam pasaran monopoli, duopoli ataupun oligopoli. Sekiranya syarikat-syarikat ini dilupuskan, kuasa pasaran akan jatuh kepada syarikat-syarikat swasta yang mementingkan keuntungan. Mereka mungkin juga akan membeli saham syarikat berkaitan kerajaan yang dilupuskan untuk menjadi lebih berkuasa.

19. Kerajaan harus memecah kecil syarikat-syarikatnya sebelum membuat pelupusan. Dengan bilangan pemain yang tinggi di pasaran, persaingan dapat ditingkatkan. Ini mendatangkan kebaikan kepada pengguna atau rakyat. Pemain-pemain industri pula tidak seharusnya membeli saham syarikat yang akan dilupuskan.

20. Niat pihak tertentu dalam mencadangkan pelupusan syarikat berkaitan kerajaan perlu dilihat semula. Apabila syarikat berkaitan kerajaan berjaya, mereka mendakwa kerajaan tidak boleh mengambil untung dengan memasuki pasaran. Tetapi apabila syarikat kerajaan mengalami kerugian, mereka mengatakan kerajaan lemah dalam perniagaan. Mereka sebenarnya ingin menguasai pasaran.

Kuasa Majoriti

21. Banyak suara-suara lantang datang dari beberapa pihak tertentu sahaja. Suara mereka akhirnya diambil kira dalam menggubal dasar-dasar baru kerajaan. ON THE BEAT WITH WONG CHUN WAI

IT'S becoming tiring for many Malaysians. We are talking about our politicians and supporters regardless of their political affiliations.

Take, for example, the organisers of Bersih 2.0. They need to realise that not all Malaysians are their fans. Not all share their beliefs and decision to stage a rally in Kuala Lumpur.

Their supporters have the right to argue and convince others that it is their constitutional right to protest but, again, do not expect everyone to share their enthusiasm.

When jazz singer Datuk Sheila Majid tweeted: "I am disappointed with all political parties, NGOs and Bersih. There are better ways to approach," she immediately received a nasty rebuke from a PKR activist who shot her down, saying he used to respect her. She probably lost a fan because of her tweet.

There are enough people who would like to tell them that their protest was illegal and that they should know this is basic law.

Protesters should know better that when you attend a demonstration, it is not going to be a picnic. One should expect to be arrested and hauled into a Black Maria, so let's not kid ourselves into believing that the cops would give them a red carpet welcome.

Certainly, only a politically naive person, or someone in self-denial, would believe that Datuk S. Ambiga was acting on her own.

Yes, of course, it was not politically motivated. The opposition politicians just happened to be there. Yes, they just bumped into each other at KL Hilton.

In the case of the government, many are also shaking their heads at the authorities' sledgehammer treatment of Bersih 2.0.

Just weeks ago, not many Malaysians knew who Ambiga was. Thanks to the over-excitement of the authorities, she has become an icon overnight.

And don't blame Malaysians for being cynical over the claims that communist elements were involved in the rally. More so when those dreamer socialists were said to have T-shirts bearing the names of dead Commie leaders.

Suddenly, Che Guevera, whom many teenagers at Pertama Complex had all this while thought was Bob Marley, was declared dangerous and subversive.

Then there was the obsession with the colour yellow. By the way, there were enough Malaysians who actually believed the Digi Man was arrested by the police, although the e-mailed picture was doctored.

But it was a funny spoof, and I wish there were enough Malaysians with a sense of humour to laugh at the fat yellow man.

Arresting people who wear yellow T-shirts with the word “Bersih” is not going to help the government win votes. Something is wrong with us if we believe revolutions can be launched by wearing yellow T-shirts with the word “Bersih”.

One need not be a rocket scientist to know the political backlash of such an action, even though there may be good security measures.

And the police, trying too hard to be friendly, put on its Facebook pictures of those detained being served with a buffet meal. There were round tables covered with tablecloth. Not bad at all, man!

No wonder there are many people who think a protest in KL is really a stroll on a weekend.

And then there was Perkasa’s Datuk Ibrahim Ali. The man is really comical. After driving enough people into a frenzy with his racist tirade, he decided to stay home. At one point, he claimed he could mobilise 15,000 people. As a face-saving gesture, he declared he would take “a stroll” at Tasik Titiwangsa. It must have been a pretty long stroll. He was probably walking around in circles.

And we can assume everyone would declare themselves winners. Bersih 2.0 will say that they managed to stage a protest despite the police locking down the city.

The authorities, too, will say that they won this round by claiming that the Bersih 2.0 crowd wasn’t as massive as they had expected.

Ibrahim Ali could also declare himself a winner as he could have successfully earned a place in the Malaysian Book of Records for taking the most number of strolls at Tasik Titiwangsa.

Umno Youth’s Patriots can also claim to be winners despite walking barely 200m before being tear-gassed and arrested.

There was another record – Anwar could still post a tweet at 4.40pm that says “undergoing CT scan for injury. Wishing #Bersih all the best.”

How he could take his mobile phone into a CT scan machine is a wonder. The Opposition leader had purportedly fallen during the protest.

Either Malaysians must be very bad in Maths or they are very good at exaggerating. The police said there were only 5,000 protesters whereas Datuk A. Samad Said said 50,000 while the pro-opposition Malaysia Chronicle news portal claimed 100,000 people.

The silat exponents turned out to be a lot of hot air in the end.

The biggest losers were the public who got stuck in horrendous traffic jams. Businesses can count their losses, vendors could not distribute their newspapers, commuters found at least eight LRT stations shut, the city’s cabbies had to stay at home and, worse, terrified city dwellers had to stock up on food unnecessarily.

And taxpayers must certainly be wondering why their money is being spent on bringing so many cops into the city – and serving a buffet meal to law-breakers at Pulapol – when they should be busy catching criminals.

It must be brought to mind that not everyone who supports Bersih 2.0 are pro-opposition. Many middle class urban voters are unhappy about many issues and it won’t hurt the government to listen to them. Don’t give up on them so they won’t give up on the government. Some concerns are legitimate ones that need fixing.

Likewise, Pakatan Rakyat should not misread today’s rally as an endorsement of the Opposition.

I have the same tots with you about the GLC issue. Challenge of a new mindset

Feelings are still deeply divided over last weekend's street protests but there is a growing realisation that there is a sophisticated civil society out there who can determine the outcome of the next general election.

A DIE-HARD admirer of Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad was asked how the big man felt about his famous daughter Datuk Paduka Marina and her grown-up daughter joining the Bersih march last weekend.

The Mahathir-admirer said the former Premier felt more embarrassed than upset.

Dr Mahathir's views about public protests are well known. In fact, he had, over the last few months, expressed disapproval of the way sensitive issues like race relations and religion were openly debated and challenged, saying such things had not happened during his watch and implying that his successors have been unable to control the politics of the day.

But to have his daughter and granddaughter marching with the Bersih group was an eye-opener altogether. In a way, it was a metaphor for how the world has changed around him since the years when he was still in the driver's seat.

However, the political circle around him fumed at Marina. They think she has put her father and her deputy minister brother Datuk Mukhriz in an awkward situation. But those familiar with Marina say her support for Bersih had more to do with her NGO ties and what they stood for. Also, like many Malaysians, she wants to see a first world electoral system emerge in this country.

The problem was that Bersih was polemic from the word go and when emotions run high, there is little middle ground. It becomes a situation of you are with us or you are with them.

That has been the dilemma for many, including Deputy Higher Education Minister Datuk Saifuddin Abdullah who came under attack from pro-Umno Netizens for his views on the rally. Some of them even called for him to be sacked from the Government.

Among his "wrongs": He had questioned the authority's handling of the rally and was critical of the Friday sermons cautioning people from joining the demonstration. A day before the protests, he tweeted: "Saya tidak setuju perhimpunan Bersih tapi tak payahlah guna khutbah Jumaat." (I don't agree with the Bersih rally but there's no need to use the Friday sermon.)

He clarified later that although the rally was illegal, there was no need to resort to religious grounds to stop it. More bashing followed that remark although he also won praise for being objective. People like Saifuddin are a minority in Umno, which saw the rally as a direct challenge to its hold on power.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak acknowledged the raw feelings in the party when he made one of the most fiery speeches of his career before a packed gathering of Umno leaders and members at the party headquarters the next day. He was speaking to an emotional audience who felt that the other side was pushing them against the wall; and you could see it in their response.

Khairy Jamaluddin received loud applause at the PWTC gathering. The Umno Youth chief had also defied the ban to rally and he has been taunted for the barely 200 “Patriots” he managed to gather. But he went out there, took the hits for his party and they acknowledged it.

Umno Youth had its share of casualties. The police did not care who Khairy’s father-in-law was; they arrested him after giving him and his group the pepper water and tear gas treatment.

Bukit Bintang Youth chief Tengku Azman Zainal Abidin was whacked on his upper back while Putrajaya Youth chief Datuk Zaki Zahid is nursing a black-and-blue left arm, no thanks to a FRU baton. A member from Besut suffered a broken ankle.

The mainstay of Umno is still seething. They regard the whole affair as a veiled attempt by Pakatan Rakyat to import Egypt’s Tahrir Square phenomenon to Kuala Lumpur and destabilise the government.

“How would they feel if we take to the streets when we disagree with policies or laws in Pakatan states? You want this culture, we can do the same. They have set a dangerous precedent,” said Tengku Azman.

Claiming credit

Pakatan leaders, who kept to the background in the run-up to the protests, are now emerging to claim credit while threatening more street protests.

The rally was also very much about political gamesmanship and there is no denying that Pakatan has regained the momentum they lost following the string of by-election defeats and the sex video scandal. Public perception is that the Government could have handled it with more finesse, however.

PAS leaders, in particular, are milking the afterglow for all it is worth. Deputy president Mohamad Sabu, who was injured in the knee, has been making the ceramah rounds in a wheelchair where he is welcomed like a war hero. Shah Alam MP Khalid Samad who received about half a dozen stitches to his scalp has worn his scar like a badge of honour.

Surprisingly, pictures of Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim in hospital with tubes running out of his nose elicited little sympathy and some thought his bodyguard, who was seen with blood dribbling down his cheek and chin, should be the one stretched out.

A key concern of PAS was its standing with the palace because the rally had gone on despite the advice from the King. The latest issue of Harakah went into overdrive to contain the matter, carrying the King's picture on the front cover as well as the back page while pinning the blame of treachery squarely on Umno.

A point of curiosity was the DAP's role, or rather the lack of it. Key DAP leaders kept a low profile before and after the showdown. Questions are being asked whether they were trying to downplay their political clout after their massive wins in Sarawak or if they were apprehensive about the sentiments of the Chinese middleground regarding Middle East-style uprisings. According to an insider, the party did not want to be seen as the provocateur, so they played safe.

Besides, Penang Chief Minister Lim Guan Eng had a foretaste of this in his own state several days before the Bersih show. DAP leaders probably know they would be giving their opponents an excuse to retaliate the same way in Penang if they had actively encouraged the Bersih rally.

Will there be more rallies to come?

Bersih chief Datuk S. Ambiga said quite firmly there would be no more Bersih rallies for now. Her NGO coalition worked hand in glove with Pakatan to organise the demonstrations but she apparently does not intend to let Pakatan politicians hijack the movement and turn it into a yellow bandwagon for them to roll into Putrajaya. It will be a test of whether she is really in charge or whether it is the Pakatan leaders who are running the show.

Pakatan politicians know a good thing when they see one. They have been tweeting and making press statements about "yellow Saturdays" and holding more gatherings.

“The key challenge for them is how to maintain the momentum, to distinguish between the NGO and Pakatan arms of Bersih and how to stick to the agenda of electoral reform.

“For Pakatan, it is about how to build a broader movement by bringing in groups with grievances on issues such as inflation and corruption.

“But, by and large, we are a functioning democracy, the election process still works, and the way forward is to find a way to mediate between the demands and politics of these groups,” said Merdeka Centre director Ibrahim Suffian.

The way the rally unfolded has hurt the image of Najib’s administration but it has not undone the good he has done, as some claimed.

Najib, as Ibrahim pointed out, has tried very hard to be seen as more than just another politician. He has put into place policies and measures which he believes will be beneficial for the future of the country. It is there for people to judge alongside the political fallout from Bersih.

Within Umno, there is a segment who understands the civil society value of the Bersih demands. They agree with the bigger goals of free and fair elections even while opposed to the way the organisers took it to the streets.

“We are not afraid of reform and progress. I have no problems with the call for greater media freedom. We opposed the rally not because we are against principles of fair elections, but because the rally became a political challenge,” said Umno Youth’s Zaki.

For Umno, especially, the rally was a wake-up call. The large number of young Malays on the streets was the very sort of people which Umno Youth should be attracting but instead they were out there with the other side.

The Malays came out in huge numbers because there is a lot at stake for them – the Prime Minister will be a Malay and as Muslims, they want control over the question of Islam in the country. Moreover, the Malays/Bumiputras will determine the politics of the future because by

2020, they will make up 70% of the population.

On Thursday evening, Umno's Saifuddin gathered a group of like-minded people to share and discuss the events of the past weeks and how to go beyond what had happened. Saifuddin is what one might call the thinking person's type of politician.

New perspective

The group is talking about engagement, about looking at issues in terms of grey rather than just black and white. This group sees the diversity of views out there and they understand how important it is to command the middle ground.

Zaki, on his part, has invited his peer group from Pakatan parties to sit down and debate electoral issues.

They realise that the most significant aspect of last Saturday's protest was the participation of civil society and the number of people who declared that they were there not to support PAS or PKR or Anwar Ibrahim, but because they want a better electoral system.

"These are the people who will eventually vote for the candidate rather than the party. They go on issues, they can distinguish between party politics and real issues," said one senior journalist.

If not for anything else, Saturday has shown that there is a very sophisticated and discerning civil society out there and they are not afraid to make their opinions known.

This group will be a major factor in determining the outcome of the next general election and political parties should do everything they can to engage them.

Political parties bring in the most but 40% are ineligible

PUTRAJAYA: Voter registration numbers have gone up significantly, thanks to efforts by political parties.

But some 40% of the new voters they have registered turned out to be ineligible.

“Some are dead, underage or already registered voters,” said Election Commission (EC) chairman Tan Sri Abdul Aziz Mohd Yusof.

“We verify with the National Registration Department (NRD) those who are genuine and get rid of the names of those who are not. This makes it tiring because we have to keep checking,” he told The Star.

Despite this, he said, political parties still registered the highest number, bringing in more than half of the new eligible voters.

“Compared to universities and NGOs, the voters we get from political parties are a lot more,” he said.

For May alone, 52% of new eligible voters were registered by political parties.

Twenty per cent were registered through post offices and 13% by government departments.

The EC, meanwhile, roped in 10% of the new voters through its counters and outreach programme.

Universities and NGOs helped to register 3% and 2% new voters respectively.

Abdul Aziz added that the EC had appointed political parties, NGOs and universities as assistant registrars to help register new voters, paying RM1 for every clean and confirmed new voter these organisations bring in.

“If they register 1,000 new voters and only 600 are genuine, we pay them RM600,” he said.

Between 2008 and 2009, there were 10 million registered voters in the country and another 4.3 million eligible voters who were not registered.

This year, the total number of registered voters increased to 12 million and eligible unregistered voters dropped to 3.7 million.

“We have made registration easy and simple. You can go to the post office, youth bodies, universities, colleges, government departments, NGOs and political parties to register,” he added.

Abdul Aziz said the Malaysian EC was the only one in the world that appointed political parties to assist in registering new voters.

He pointed out that it made sense to rope in political parties.

“We appoint an average of two assistant registrars for each state seat. And because they have an interest, they work very hard to register new voters.

“When we do the voter registration ourselves, the response is not very good. We go to events like TV3’s Jom Heboh to register new voters but it is difficult for people to come forward.

“This has to do with attitude. People ask what benefit they get by registering as voters. Some people do not have the spirit. They ask what happens if they don’t register and when they find out no action is taken, they leave it as it is. Only those who really love the country and would like to choose their own leaders would voluntarily go and register as voters.”

Abdul Aziz also advised the people to vote in their current place of residence as this was stipulated in the law. This would also resolve the issue of phantom voters, where voters allegedly stay in a different place from where they cast their vote.

He said people should not feel attachment to their hometown and balik kampung to cast their votes.

“If I stay in Shah Alam, I shouldn’t go back to Penang or my hometown to vote,” he said.

He estimated that about 30% to 40% of Malaysians voted in a different place or state than where they lived.

“I have no power to force them to vote where they live. I can only explain and persuade them,” he added.

Woodbury Common comes to Kulai on 11-11-11

JOHOR BARU: Shopping for branded products will be the attraction for visitors to Kulai after the Johor Premium Outlet (JPO) opens its doors on the auspicious date of Nov 11 or 11.11.11.

Designer brands like Burberry, Coach, Polo, Ralph Lauren, Prada, Armani, Canali, Ferragamo, Tod's, Zegna, Nike and Puma will be featured in the RM149mil outlet.

The outlet will be located on an 18ha site and will sell the products, which will be a season old, at 25% to 60% cheaper than the malls.

The project is a 50-50 joint venture between Genting's 54.6% owned subsidiary Genting Plantations Bhd and Premium Outlets, a division of US-based Simon Property Group.

The outlet is about 80% complete and is based on Simon's flagship Premium Outlet "Woodbury Common" just outside New York. There are 52 such outlets in the United States, Mexico, Japan and South Korea while the JPO would be the first in South-East Asia.

A purpose-built flyover is being completed on the Second Link to ensure a smooth connection from Singapore and the North-South Expressway.

Menteri Besar Datuk Abdul Ghani Othman said the project would significantly increase the number of visitors to the state both from other states and from Singapore.

“The JPO construction is on schedule and it will open in the third quarter of the year as scheduled,” Ghani said.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak is scheduled to open the JPO and has indicated that it should be done on Nov 11 because of the auspicious date.

JPO director Datuk Justin Leong said the company planned to bus in visitors from all over Malaysia and Singapore, and use the Senai airport to bring in regional tourists from countries like Indonesia and Thailand.

“This is an exciting development for Johor and Malaysia as it will be a key driver for retail tourism.

This will also feature Iskandar Malaysia on the map,” he said.
