Now if you consider the Chinese to comprise 26% of Malaysia's 12 million population then as compared to the Bumis 62% majority population, and if on the average a Malaysian family has 6 household members, there were then 520,000 Chinese families and with a ratio of 1 in 5 Chinese family affordably sent a child to further studies overseas.

In comparison, there were 1.24 million Bumi families, and a ratio of 1 in 62 Bumi family having a child studying overseas ON SCHOLARSHIP!

The statistics were far worse and to the Bumi's disadvantage before the May 13 '69 racial riots.

I strongly believe the Malaysian Chinese shudder at the thought of its recurrence.

If you had signed a contract with Britain, you MUST fully abide to it and the same applies to the British.

Even when the late Mao Tze Tong was at his peak, the mighty Communist China dared not take back tiny Hong Kong from Britain!

"Oleh kerana perjalanan menyeberangi lautan luas & bergelora dengan sehelai sepinggang hanya untuk meneruskan kehidupan dibumi Melayu ini setelah melalui kesengsaraan hidup dibumi asal, dan juga disamping mengharapkan sangat2 kesenangan yang dimimpikan, pendatang yang kelaparan ini terus membanting tulang berkerja dengan pulun dan rakus tanpa henti untuk mengubah nasib dan kehidupan

mereka.

“Disebabkan tiada saingan dari orang Melayu yang ketika itu tiada mempunyai apa2 tekanan menghadapi survival kerana berada ditengah tumpah darah nenek moyang, kejayaan pendatang2 tersebut memperbaiki ekonomi yang amat2 di kejar/harapkan mudah tercapai. Tambahan pula orang2 Inggeris yang merupakan Godfather kaum pendatang memberikan laluan mudah untuk mereka berjaya, dan seterusnya dapat mengurangkan risiko kebangkitan orang Melayu menentang mereka.

“Penyelesaian telah dipersetujui oleh setiap pemimpin yang mewakili kaum masing2, dan dirumuskan dengan 3 perkara terpenting yang termaktub dalam perlembagaan:

1. Hak2 istimewa kaum Bumiputera.
2. Islam agama resmi, berserta dengan perkara2 yang telah digariskan.
3. Semua pendatang diberi taraf kewarganegaraan.

“Setiap yang mengaku diri mereka itu adalah rakyat Persekutuan Tanah Melayu/Malaysia, adalah WAJIB menghormati ketiga2 artikel diatas!!

“Apabila usia negara meningkat, kaum Bumiputera telah ditentang untuk menuntut hak2 keistimewaan seperti termaktub dan agama Islam telah cuba dipertingkatkan oleh mereka, sedangkan kewarganegaraan percuma yang mereka perolehi dengan cara paling mudah tidak pernah dipertikai!

“Penjajah Inggeris pun tidak sejahat dan sejiik perbuatan2 terkutuk oleh kaum keturunan pendatang biadap ini!

“Kaum keturunan pendatang tidak berpuas hati dengan 70% kekayaan negara yang telah dijanjikan sebagai hak mereka!!!(sic)”
