

PSRM leader to NBI: Show proof of probe

JOHORE BARU, Fri. - Partai Sosialis Rakyat Malaysia secretary-general Abdul Razak Ahmad today challenged the National Bureau of Investigation to make public its records into the party's allegations of corruption by Government officials and politicians.

Encik Razak was commenting on a statement by the Deputy Minister in the Prime Minister's Department, Datuk Abdullah Abdul Rahman, that PSRM's allegations of corruption in the government were fully investigated.

"I am not convinced by the Deputy Minister's statement. The Johore NBI dare not act against highly placed government officials and politicians suspected of graft," he said.

"I have made many

complaints regarding corruption within the Government and the private sector but the NBI here has taken no action," Encik Razak said.

"Because of this I have been forced to bring the matter to court," Encik Razak said.

Encik Razak filed a writ in court two weeks ago against the chief executive of the State and the Johore Government for improper land distribution in Mersing.

The court has set hearing for February.

Referring to the Tasek Maju incident, Encik Razak said although he was the complainant in the case, he was never called for an interview to present his facts and findings. The complaint was filed in 1978.

"The NBI should have

interviewed me. They should act quickly because the major shareholder is a foreigner and he may abscond," Encik Razak said.

Encik Razak, who is also Johore PSRM chairman, alleged there were two senior Government officials involved in the case.

He also referred to another case where an Executive Councillor would not explain how he got \$500,000 in shares in a housing developer's firm.

Encik Razak said he had written to the NBI but nothing has been done.

"I gave out leaflets containing my allegations to the public and sent a copy to the NBI. If anything has been or is being done about this, let the NBI make its records public and prove their claims by deeds, not words," Encik Razak said.
