

# ALL SET-FOUR MEN TO FIGHT FOR CHOY'S SEAT

PENANG, Thurs. - The Pengkalan Kota by-election on Nov. 15 will be a four-cornered fight among the Barisan Nasional, DAP and two independent candidates.

State MCA chief Lim Kean Siew represents the Barisan while the DAP is represented by its State organising secretary, Mr Teoh Teik Huat. The two independents are Mr Lim Ewe Chin, an assistant manager, and businessman Tan Kee Chye.

Their nomination papers were accepted by returning officer Jamaludin bin Haji Abu Bakar at the nomination centre at Dewan Sri Pinang.

There was an objection over Mr Tan's nomination papers but it was overruled.

Supporters of the four candidates later marched out of the Dewan Sri Pinang in their show of strength.

Mr Lim Ewe Chin will use a bunch of keys as his election symbol while Mr Tan will use a hook.

Earlier, a group of about 500 Barisan members and supporters accompanied Mr Lim Kean Siew to the Dewan Sri Pinang.

About half an hour later, a group of about 50 supporters arrived with Mr Lim Ewe Chin. The DAP's group arrived minutes later.

Mr Lim Kean Siew was the first to file in his nomination papers. He was followed by Mr Lim Ewe Chin, Mr Teoh and Mr Tan.

MCA president Datuk Lee San Choon, vice-president Datuk Dr Neo Yee Pan, Deputy Finance Minister Datuk Mak Hon Kam, Deputy Culture, Youth and Sports Minister Datuk Chin Hon Ngiam and Deputy Information Minister Dr Ling Liong Sik were among MCA leaders present.

Also present were Chief Minister and State Barisan chairman Dr Lim Chong Eu. Gerakan president Dr Lim Keng Yaik, Gerakan secretary-general Datuk Teh Ewe Lim and other Gerakan leaders.
