

Landslide- victory for us in Kedah, says Mahathir

ALOR STAR, Mon.
— Kedah Umno
leader Dr. Mahathir
bin Mohamed said
today the chances of
a landslide victory
for the National
Front in K e d a h
were good.

Dr. Mahathir who was
returned unopposed in
the Kubang Pasu parlla-
mentary constituency
said in an interview that
this was because the

Coalition Government
had made concrete
achievement in all fields.

"Internationally, Ma-
laysia is regarded as a
country that has a dis-
tinct and very construc-
tive approach to inter-
national issues such as
having ties with different
bloes and also the
Islamic world," he said.

Dr. Mahathir said most
of those who opposed
the Government before
now form part of the
Government.

"If there is still opposi-
tion, such opposition is
totally aimless.

Dr. Mahathir who is
also a member of the
Umno Supreme Council,
said it would be difficult
for opposition candidates
to attack the Coalition
Government.

Jitra OCPD Asst. Supt.
Mohamed Ghazali bin
Haji Ismail said today
that police did not issue
a permit to the National
Front to hold a rally at
6th Air Itam Kediang
Road on Friday night
because the application
form did not comply to
the law.
