

Mahathir tells students: Let court decide

KUALA LUMPUR, Sat. — The Minister of Education, Dr. Mahathir Mohamad, has expressed the hope that student leaders will allow the university to function normally as soon as possible.

On the student takeover of the university campus, he said: "I don't know why the students have done this because this has nothing to do with education at all."

He said students could not do whatever they liked out-

side the campus. They had broken the law and would have to "face the music."

He added: "The matter of the arrested students is one for the courts to decide and neither the Prime Minister nor the Minister of Education can do anything about it."

The Attorney-General and Minister of Law, Tan Sri Kadir Yusof advised the students to be patient and to wait for the court to decide on their two members in Johore Baru. The two will be produced in court on Thursday.
