

Be responsible, Mahathir urges students

— Students will not succeed in their claims by demonstrating and ignoring regulations, Education Minister Dr.

Mahathir Mohamed said today.

They should be responsible at all times and should work to become better students.

Speaking to students of the Tun Fatimah School here, he stressed problems faced by the pupils could be settled through proper channels like parent-teacher associations.

The Minister regretted that some stu-

dents demonstrated or boycotted classes to back "trivial" issues.

"The students themselves would suffer from such irresponsible action which would later be injurious to their future."

"Our students must be disciplined in their

actions and behaviour and they must comply with the rules imposed on them," Dr. Mahathir added.

"We want foreign countries to look up to our nation and so therefore, we need to set up a truly disciplined society starting from schoolchildren."
