upset by

issues,
Mahathir**

tells pupils

— Education Minister Dr. Mahathir Mohamed (above) advised students today not to demonstrate or go on strike over small disagreements.

They should, instead, bring their problems to the proper channels, for example, the Parents-Teachers Association.

Dr. Mahathir, on a two-day visit here, was speaking to the students of Sekolah Tun Fatimah.

He said the students should not waste time through demonstrations "just because you don't take to a teacher or school gardener."

'Show respect'

"Our students should be more disciplined in their activities and must show greater respect for regulations," he added.

He was later briefed by State Director of Education, Encik Ahmad Haji Salleh at the State Operations Room here.

Dr. Mahathir told reporters that schools with good facilities should help smaller schools by sharing the facilities.

In this way, more students would benefit, he added.
