

# Some students planning 'hate' drive: Mahathir

A group of university students from Yen, Central Kedah, is planning a hate campaign against elected representatives of the National Front, Education Minister Dr. Mahathir bin Mohamed said today.

These students, who were active in the Kubang Pasu constituency which he represented, were directing their campaign particularly

at him, the Minister added.

"Their aim is to create trouble because they dislike the Barisan Nasional ruling the country," Dr. Mahathir said.

He was speaking at a dialogue session with residents of Kampung Raja, near Padang Serai.

Dr. Mahathir said he was not worried about the students' activities because he was confident the people would not be easily misled.

He recalled that when the country achieved independence, the Malays were behind the other

races as their rural areas had been neglected by the British who concentrated developing the towns.

Since then, the Alliance, and now the National Front Government, had sought to bring the living standard of the Malays to the level of the other races.

Dr. Mahathir said the National Front would bring greater advantages to the people.

If his constituents did not like him to be their representative in Parliament, he said they could oust him at the next general elections.
