P KUALA LUMPUR, APRIL 7 (BERNAMA) — EDUCATION MINISTER, DR. MAHATHIR MOHAMED HAS EXPRESSED CONFIDENCE THAT STERN ACTION INCLUDING THE DETENTION OF STUDENTS AND LECTURERS INVOLVED IN LAST YEAR'S DEMONSTRATIONS, WOULD PRODUCE THE DESIRED RESULTS.
