KUALA LUMPUR, JUNE 17 (BERNAMA) -- THE TRADE AND INDUSTRY MINISTRY HAS APPROVED 130 INVESTMENT PROJECTS AS A RESULT OF THE MALAYSIAN INVESTMENT PROMOTION MISSIONS TO 11 COUNTRIES SINCE 1978.
