KUALA LUMPUR, NOV. 11 (BERNAMA) - DATUK SERI DR. MAHATHIR MOHAMAD HAS DIRECTED MINISTERS AND THEIR DEPUTIES TO REFRAIN FROM USING TINTED GLASS ON THEIR CARS ALTHOUGH EXISTING LAWS PERMIT THEM TO DO SO.

DEPUTY TRANSPORT MINISTER DATUK ABU HASSAN HAJI OMAR DISCLOSED THIS IN THE DEWAN RAKYAT TODAY.

HE SAID UNDER THE EXISTING REGULATION VIPS PERMITTED TO USE TINTED GLASS ON THEIR CARS WERE THE YANG DI-PERTUAN AGONG, RULERS, YANG DI PERTUA NEGRI, MINISTERS, MENTRI BESAR/CHIEF MINISTERS, JUDGES AND POLICE AND ARMY OFFICERS APPROVED BY THE INSPECTOR GENERAL OF POLICE OR THE CHIEF OF DEFENCE FORCES.

REPLYING TO A SUPPLEMENTARY QUESTION FROM ENCIK CHAN TECK CHAN (BN-KOTA BALEBUA), HE SAID 155 OWNERS OF VEHICLES HAD BEEN BOOKED UNTIL AUGUST FOR USING TINTED GLASS.
