KUALA LUMPUR, MAY 9 (BERNAMA) -- (DATUK SERI DR MAHATHIR MOHAMAD HAS DIRECTED CABINET MINISTERS AND SENIOR OFFICIALS TO REACT "POSITIVELY" TO COMPLAINTS ABOUT THEIR ACTIONS.
