**PENANG, Sun.** — A police report was made today against Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad for driving a car without a number plate, road tax and insurance.

Sungai Pinang DAP branch chairman Chew Seng Poh made the report at the Jelutong police station at 12.10pm after reading newspaper reports of Dr Mahathir's drive across the Penang Bridge yesterday.

In his report, he urged

the police to take the necessary action against the Prime Minister for breaking traffic rules.

Mr Chew said the Prime Minister's action was "bad leadership by example".

Police confirmed that a report had been made.

However, it is understood no action will be taken as the bridge has yet to be gazetted as a public road. It will only be open to the public from Sept 15.
