

MP Haji Daud named new Deputy Minister

KUALA LUMPUR, Thurs — Datuk Dr Ling Liong Sik and Datuk Lee Kim Sai have been re-appointed Deputy Ministers.

A statement from the Prime Minister's Department today announced the appointment of Datuk Dr Ling as Deputy Education Minister. His previous post was Deputy Finance Minister.

Datuk Lee goes back to his former post in the Prime Minister's Department.

In the minor reshuffle of the administration, Deputy Education Minister Datin Paduka Rosemary Chong is moved to the Culture, Youth and Sports Ministry.

The statement also announced

the appointment of Batu Pahat MP Haji Daud Taha as the Deputy Public Enterprises Minister.

Oath of office

Haji Daud is chairman of the Public Accounts Committee and deputy chairman of the Islamic Economic Development Foundation of Malaysia. An accountant by profession, he is chairman of the Batu Pahat division and treasurer of the Johore State Umno.

The statement said the appointment of Haji Daud was necessary because of increasing workload of the Public Enterprises Ministry.

The changes announced today have received the consent of the Yang di-Pertuan Agong and will take effect from the time the Deputy Ministers take the oath of office, which is expected to be soon.
