Now Aligned Nation

AS MORE AND MORE LEADERS WANT TO SPEAK, CHAIRMAN ROBERT MUGABE HAS EXTENDED SESSIONS TO LATE AT NIGHT. A DELEGATE SAID THAT IN THE DELHI SUMMIT OF 1983, INTERPRETERS WALKED OUT WHEN WHEN THEY COULD NOT COPE WITH THE LATE SESSIONS AND COMMITTEE MEETINGS. 5.9-86.

JOURNALISTS WHO HAD EALIER BOUGHT COPIES OF THE POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC DRAFT REPORTS FOR AS MUCH AS DLRS 2 25 MIGHT END UP SPENDING MORE AS THERE ARE MANY CHANGES TO THE REPORTS.

A DELEGATE SAID THE AMENDMENTS TO ONE REPORT ALONE CAME TO MORE THAN THE PAGES OF THE REPORT ITSELF.

MEANWHILE, THERE ARE RUMOURS IN THE MEDIA CENTRE AMONG JOURNALISTS OF A COUP IN LIBERIA AND THAT MALAYSIA AND PERU ARE LIKELY TO BE HOSTS OF THE NEXT SUMMIT IN VIEW OF THE DEADLOCK BETWEEN INDONESIA AND NICARAGUA.

IRAN HAS LODGED A PROTEST WITH THE ZBC (ZIMBABWEAN BROADCASTING CORPORATION) WHEN A LIVE BROADCAST OF PRESIDENT ALI KHAMENI'S SPEECH WAS SUDDENLY CUT OFF ON SEPT 2. ZIMBABWEAN INFORMATION MINISTER NATHAN SHAMUYARIRA HAS APOLOGISED AND PROMISED THAT THE PRESIDENT'S SPEECH WILL BE BROADCAST AGAIN.

THE FINAL HARARE DECLARATION WILL +TAKE NOTE+ OF THE SETTING UP OF THE INDEPENDENT COMMISSION OF THE SOUTH ANNOUNCED BY MALAYSIAN PRIME MINISTER DATUK SERI DR MAHATHIR MOHAMAD ON SEPT 3. CONFERENCE SOURCES SAID THIS WAS SIGNIFICANT FOR ALTHOUGH IT WAS NOT A DOCUMENT OF THE CONFERENCE, THE EIGHTH SUMMIT HAD ACKNOWLEDGED ITS IMPORTANCE. -- MORE (ENDS CORRECTED REPETITION)
