

# All will gain from Govt projects.

BACHOK, Sat. — Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr. Mahathir Mohamad today urged the people to support the Government and ensure the smooth implementation of its projects.

This was because they would be the ones to benefit from such projects.

He said despite the present economic situation, the Government continued with the various development projects aimed at upgrading the standard of living of the people, especially the fishermen and those in the lower income groups.

"There is no reason for anyone to condemn the Government because those who are against the Government will also benefit from these projects," he said.

"These people should be grateful to the Government for all the things it had done in ensuring that the people were provided with the amenities to help upgrade their standard of living," he added.

Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir said the people should accept the fact that the Government was sincere in wanting to help them upgrade their standard of living, but added that this could not be achieved without their support and co-operation.

He expressed the need for the people to have a positive attitude and work hard by utilising the facilities provided to improve their life.

"The provision of the various infrastructure projects alone will not help to improve life if the people are unwilling to work hard," he said.

Datuk Mahathir added that the Government spent a large sum of money for the projects but this would be a waste unless it is properly utilised by the people.

The Prime Minister and his wife Datin Seri Dr Siti Hasmah who were here to visit the site of the breakwater of the Kemasin-Semerak project being constructed told the large crowd that had gathered at Kuala Kemasin to welcome them that the Government gave priority to projects which will benefit the poor.
