

# Tunku: Have an agenda for reconciliation talks

PENANG, Fri. — Tunku Abdul Rahman proposed today that an agenda be drawn up for reconciliation talks between former Umno leaders and Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

He said the agenda should be drawn up by the two parties and that they should agree on it or the meeting would be a waste of time.

The Tunku was commenting on a statement by Datuk Musa Hitam on Wednesday night that former Umno leaders were prepared to discuss reconciliation with the Umno Baru president for the sake of Malay unity.

The Tunku said Datuk Musa had asked him to give his views on the proposed talk with Dr Mahathir.

The Tunku said the talks to find ways to get Umno back to its feet had to be done "through the right course of action."

"Tengku Razaleigh and the other 11 people are keen to find a solution to bring all the Malays together. The dissolution of the old Umno has broken the Malay unity," he said.

"To us and the Malays, Umno is Malay and Malay is Umno, so let us get Umno back to its feet," he added.

In Kuala Lumpur, Umno Baru Youth international affairs bureau committee member Haji Mustapha Yaakub hoped Umno Baru leaders would consider Datuk Musa's proposal.

He said it was not too late to reach a conclusive solution to the problems facing the party for the good of all concerned.

"What is important is that there must be sincerity in wanting to solve the problem facing Umno. We also hope that all parties involved will give positive views to Dr Mahathir on this matter," Haji Mustapha said.
