

Dr M: I will meet anyone

KUALA LUMPUR, Fri. — Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad said he was prepared to meet anyone interested in Malay unity but there must not be any condition to the talks.

The Prime Minister and Umno Baru president said he had met Datuk Musa Hitam several times in the past and was prepared to discuss with him again over any issue.

Dr Mahathir was responding to questions on Datuk Musa's statement on Wednesday night

that former Umno leaders were prepared to discuss reconciliation with him.

Datuk Musa said in Johore Baru that he and Gua Musang MP Tengku Razaleigh Hamzah were prepared to meet Dr Mahathir and his deputy Abdul Ghafar Baba to try to work out a solution for the unity of the race.

He said that "it all depends on Dr Mahathir."

Tengku Razaleigh said in Kota Baru yesterday that Datuk Musa's statement was made with

his agreement.

Dr Mahathir told reporters after chairing an Umno Baru supreme council meeting today, that "our doors had always been open for discussions."

"However, let us not confine ourselves to anyone in particular, to any number of people. We do not mind discussing matters of mutual interest with anybody. But why should it be any particular person? Why not 10 people instead of just two, three or four?" he asked.
