

Mahathir warded

for chest pains

KUALA LUMPUR, Wed.
— Prime Minister Datuk
Seri Dr Mahathir Moha-
mad was admitted to the
Kuala Lumpur General
Hospital early today after
complaining of chest
pains.

He was admitted at
1am. Later, several Ca-
binet Ministers and other
leaders visited him.

Among those at the hos-
pital was his deputy, En-
cik Abdul Ghafai Baba,
who arrived at about 8am.

After visiting the Prime
Minister, Trade and In-
dustry Minister Datin Pa-
duka Rafidah Aziz told re-
porters that "he is all
right and resting."

Other Ministers who
called on Dr Mahathir in-
cluded Datuk S. Samy
Vellu (Works), Datuk Seri
Mohamed Najib Tun Ra-
zak (Youth and Sports),
Encik Anwar Ibrahim
(Education), Datuk Seri
Sanusi Junid (Agricul-
ture), Datuk Leo Moggie
(Energy, Telecommunica-
tions and Posts) and Da-
tuk Sabbaruddin Chik
(Culture and Tourism).

Inspector-General of
Police Tan Sri Mohamed
Haniff Omar and Usno
president Tun Datu Mus-
tapha Harun also visited
the Prime Minister.

Bername quoted hospi-
tal director Datuk Dr C.
Fonseka as saying that the
condition of Dr Mahathir
