SPEAKING TO REPORTERS AFTER THE BRIEFING, THE PRIME MINISTER SAID HE WAS THANKFUL TO ALLAH THAT HE WAS ABLE TO RESUME WORK FOLLOWING THE OPERATION AT THE KUALA LUMPUR GENERAL HOSPITAL ON JAN 24.
