

I'll find ways to solve problem says **PM**

KUALA LUMPUR, Mon. — Prime Minister Datuk Seri **Dr Mahathir Mohamad** said today he will find ways to solve the problem of finding candidates to represent Kelantan in the Cabinet.

He said that at this point there was no representative from the State, in view of the defeat of BN candidates in Kelantan.

In reply to questions at a Press conference at the Putra World Trade Centre early this morning, Dr Mahathir said: "We have no intention of grabbing all the seats for ourselves that there will be no representative from other states in the Cabinet."

On an imminent Cabinet reshuffle, the Prime Minister said that since those who lost their seats could not be included in the Cabinet, the reshuffle "would not be too major".

"Most of the Cabinet members have performed well. We will not deliberately play musical chairs."

On the performance of Gerakan in Penang, Dr Mahathir said the party fared quite well.
