

# Dr M seeks treatment for wrist injury

KUALA LUMPUR, Sun. — Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, was treated for a minor wrist injury at the Kuala Lumpur General Hospital, this afternoon.

He arrived at the hospital at 12.15pm and underwent an X-ray.

He is believed to have hurt his wrist during a fall in his house, *Sri Perdana*, in the morning.

The hospital's director, Datuk Megat Burhainuddin Megat Abdul Rahman, confirmed the matter, saying that the Prime Minister's wrist injury was not serious.

However, he said, the wrist had to be kept bandaged to check any swelling.

The Prime Minister was allowed to leave the hospital after about half an hour.

Despite the injury, Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir carried on with his schedule.
