MIRI, Sept 12 (Bernama) Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad today urged the people of Sarawak to retain the politics of development practised by the state government.

He said the policy benefited the people as development was being carried out in all parts of the state.

Such a policy would ensure rapid progress of the state, he said when launching a 19 km feeder road between Bekenu town and the Miri Bintulu main road, about 70 km from here.
