

Dr Mahathir names line-up in Kelantan

KUALA LUMPUR, Thurs. — The Kelantan Barisan Nasional, chaired by Umno president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, today announced the line-up of coalition leaders in the State liaison steering committee.
