PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SECTOR TO WORK TOGETHER TO BUILD THE NATION

KUALA LUMPUR, Dec 6⁹² (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad has called on the public and private sectors to work together to develop the nation.

He said the government felt that there was a merit in the idea that public sector co-operate with the private sector instead of confronting each other.

+The co-operation between the two sectors has contributed to the progress made by Malaysia in the past few years, + he said at the dinner of the Malaysian Incorporated Games 1992 here tonight.

He said it was not a bad idea for both sectors to work together and the Chief Secretary to the Government had drawn up a long list of the do's and don't about Malaysia incorporated.
