

# Dr M: PAS has not fulfilled promise to voters

KOTA BARU: Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad said yesterday PAS had failed to fulfil its promise to implement *hudud* law in Kelantan.

He said the people in the state should not have faith in the party any longer since it was very clear that PAS had raised the issue to gain votes and not out of religious sincerity.

PAS' excuse that the enforcement of *hudud* law was postponed due to the people's ignorance was a poor cover-up for its inability to complete what it had started, the Prime Minister told some 3,000 residents during his meeting with Barisan Nasional party leaders.

Dr Mahathir, who is Kelantan Umno liaison committee chairman, said Semangat 46 had been dominated by PAS to such an extent that it did not have any more say over state affairs.

He also said many countries dared not criticise the Western powers for their inaction in Bosnia out of fear their financial aid would be cut.

The Prime Minister said when Malaysia asked other nations to support its call to criticise and pressure the West and the United States for more actions to stop the Bosnian war, these countries declined even though they knew they should.
