

Sanusi has not quit the Cabinet, says Dr M

PETALING JAYA: Agriculture Minister Datuk Seri Sanusi Junid has not quit his Cabinet post, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad said yesterday.

Confirming that they had met in London, Dr Mahathir said it was not true that Sanusi had handed him his resignation letter at the meeting.

"All we talked about was the latest developments in the party," Dr Mahathir told reporters after arriving home from the Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting in Cyprus.

A TV station here reported last week that Sanusi had submitted his resignation letter to Dr Mahathir.

However, Sanusi, who is closely aligned to Abdul Ghafar Baba, has denied it.

On CHOGM, the Prime Minister said he was "a bit saddened" by the lack of attention given to the Bosnian issue.

He said that except for a few Asian countries there seemed to be a lack of sympathy for Bosnia among developing countries.

He also said Proton must start selling its cars in Malta again.
