

Kelantan Umno's problems 'resolved'

KUALA LUMPUR, Fri. —
Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mo-
hamad said tonight that
most of the problems faced
by Kelantan Umno had been
resolved although the list of
its protem divisional heads
had not been finalised.

Dr Mahathir said the
problems were resolved dur-
ing a two-hour meeting of
the State Umno liaison com-
mittee members he chaired
at the Putra World Trade
Centre here tonight.

Asked whether the pro-
tem chairman had been de-
cided, he said it was not an
issue.

"What is more important
is that there is unity among
the Kelantan Umno mem-
bers," he added.

The list could not be fina-
lised earlier because of some
internal problems and the
liaison committee had to
wait for Dr Mahathir to re-
turn from overseas to look
into the matter.

Kelantan Umno liaison
committee deputy chair-
man Datuk Annuar Musa
had said earlier today that
he had submitted a list of 21
names for the posts of divi-
sional heads to Dr Mahathir
before the Prime Minister
left on vacation and later for
an official visit to France.

Asked whether his forth-
coming visits to the various
States had anything to do
with the coming general
elections, Dr Mahathir said
they were not.
