

Dr M gives organisers pat on the back

PRIME MINISTER Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad yesterday congratulated the organiser of the Langkawi International Maritime and Aerospace Exhibition for a job well-done.

He said the Cabinet at its weekly meeting held at Gunung Raya Conference Centre discussed Lima '95 and agreed that it was a success.
