ANWAR AT SECOND PACIFIC DIALOGUE DINNER

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 7 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim tonight attended a dinner held here in conjunction with the Second Pacific Dialogue.

About 200 people attended the dinner hosted by Hicom Holdings Berhad President Datuk Seri Yahaya Ahmad at a leading hotel here.
