ANWAR BIDS FUJIMORI FAREWELL

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 22 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim sent Peruvian President Alberto Fujimori off at the Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport in Subang, near here, tonight.

Fujimori and his delegation, including several Cabinet ministers and corporate leaders left for Tokyo after a three-day official visit to Malaysia.

Present at the airport were Rural Development Minister Datuk Annuar Musa, who is the acting Foreign Minister, and Land and Cooperative Development Minister Datuk Osu Sukam, who is the minister-in-attendance.

Fujimori, who arrived here on Wednesday, had an audience with the Yang di-Pertuan Agong, Tuanku Ja'afar, and discussions with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad on bilateral trade, investment cooperation and international issues.

He was also conferred an honorary Doctor of Science degree by Universiti Pertanian Malaysia.

Several memorandums of understanding were also signed by the private sectors of the two countries during the visit. -- BERNAMA
