ANWAR TELL UMNO CLUBS 'ALL ARE PRESIDENT'S MEN'

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 12 (Bernama) -- Members of Umno Clubs formed by Malaysian students abroad have been reminded to ignore reports of so-called "Mahathir camp or Anwar camp".

According to Chicago Umno Club president Ahmad Ikram Ismail, Deputy Prime Minister and Umno deputy president Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim gave the reminder during a meeting with 23 representatives of Umno Clubs at the party headquarters today.

Ahmad Ikram, who led the club delegation, said Anwar stressed that there did not exist two camps in the party as "all are the president's people".

Anwar also told them he would not contest against Prime Minister and party president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad whom he looked upon as a father, he said.

"Anwar always remembered the willingness of Dr Mahathir to call on him at his office (Yayasan Anda) at Jalan Pantai during the 1980s to persuade him to join Umno," said Ahmad Ikram.

He said members of the Umno Clubs did not divide themselves into camps as they were focused on continuing the struggle for the Malays.

"Many of our overseas students realise that we are able to further our education abroad because of Umno's struggle," he added. -- BERNAMA
