BN WILLING TO CONSIDER IF S46 WANTS TO JOIN COALITION

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 6 (Bernama) -- The Barisan Nasional (BN) is willing to consider if Parti Melayu Semangat 46 (S46) wants to join the coalition front, its Secretary General Datuk Mohamed Rahmat said.

"They, however, must subscribe to the BN's struggle," he said, responding to questions from reporters after breaking the fast with staff of the Information Ministry here tonight.

Mohamed, who is also Information Minister, said S46 should first make its intention known.

On today's meeting of the National Information Council, he said it had decided to hold the "Gerak Kerja Mesra" programme at the state level starting with Johor in April.

He said all states had agreed to implement the programme aimed at fostering greater unity among the people of various races in the country.

The national level programme was launched by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad in December last year. --BERNAMA
