CUEPACS TO ADOPT OPEN ATTITUDE AT MEETING WITH PM

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 28 (Bernama) -- Cuepacs, the umbrella body for public sector unions, will adopt an open attitude at its meeting with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad tomorrow, said its secretary-general N. Sivasubramaniam.

He told Bernama today the union officials will hold a heart-to-heart discussion with Dr Mahathir on issues affecting public sector employees and what role Cuepacs could play in national development.

Among the issues to be raised by Cuepacs are the method of calculating pension, housing allowance and the matrix salary scheme, he said.

Cuepacs' acting president Abdul Aziz Mohd Sultan will lead a 13-member delegation to the meeting which is scheduled at 10.30am at the Prime Minister's office.

Sivasubramaniam said Cuepacs will listen to the views of Dr Mahathir on the issues and abide by any decision made at the meeting.

"We hope something can come out of the meeting," he said. -- BERNAMA
