CZECH PRIME MINISTER ENDS THREE-DAY VISIT

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 10 (Bernama) -- The Czech Republic Prime Minister Vaclav Klaus left today after a three-day official visit to Malaysia.

He was seen off at the Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah International Airport in Subang by Foreign Minister Datuk Abdullah Ahmad Badawi.

Earlier, he received a farewell call by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad at Carcosa Sri Negara.

Klaus was accompanied by a 30-member delegation which included Deputy Prime Minister in the Prime Minister's Office Jiri Weigi and Acting Trade and Industry Deputy Minister Pavel Dvorak.

A high point of his visit was signing an Investment Guarantee Agreement with Malaysia. -- BERNAMA
