DECISION WAS UNANIMOUS, SAYS SABAH UMNO

KOTA KINABALU, Jan 29 (Bernama) -- Sabah Umno today denied a news report that some divisional leaders were not in agreement with the party's decision relating to the proposed rotation of the Chief Minister's post.

Its liaison secretary Datuk Yahya Hussin said the decision at last Saturday's meeting was unanimous as all the 20 Umno divisions had opposed the proposal.

"As such, there's no question of six divisions not concurring with the decision," he said in a statement here today.

A local newspaper reported yesterday that six divisions objected to the proposal while nine others wanted the matter left to the Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad for decision.

The report also said five other divisions were undecided at the meeting.

Yahya said the report was only made up to show that there were disagreement within Sabah Umno. --BERNAMA
