DR MAHATHIR OPENS ORPHANAGE COMPLEX

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 5 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad today officially opened the Federal Territory Darul Kifayah orphanage complex in Kampung Delima here.

The RM2-million complex, one of the biggest in the Federal Territory, houses about 100 orphans of both sexes aged between eight and 17 years.

Completed in 1993, the complex consists of two hostel blocks, a dining hall, an administration office, a playing field, sepak takraw and badminton courts as well as a surau that can accomodate 100 people.

It was developed through contributions from various sources including the Federal Territory Religious Council (MAIWP), Kuala Lumpur City Hall and individuals.

The Darul Kifayah complex is administered by MAIWP with Datuk Adam Abdul Ahad as its chairman. -- BERNAMA
