FIJIAN PRIME MINISTER LEAVES FOR HOME

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 7 (Bernama) -- Fijian Prime Minister Sitiveni Rabuka and his wife Madame Suluweti left for home tonight after a four-day official visit to Malaysia.

At the Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport in Subang to see them off were Foreign Minister Datuk Abdullah Ahmad Badawi, his wife Datin Endon Mahmood, Deputy Entrepreneurship Development Minister Idris Jusoh (who is the minister in attendance), Fijian Ambassador to Malaysia Ratu Isoa Gavididi and other senior officials.

During his stay here, Rabuka had talks with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad which centered on ways to enhance ties between the two countries.

He also had discussions with Abdullah and Defence Minister Datuk Syed Hamid Abar.

Rabuka also visited the Proton plant and Institut Teknologi Mara in Shah Alam. -- BERNAMA
