JAPANESE SENATORS CALL ON SENATE PRESIDENT

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 29 (Bernama) -- A group of five members of the Sangi-in, the Japanese House of Councillors (equivalent to the senate) and two of its senior officers called on Dewan Negara President Datuk Adam Kadir at Parliament House here today.

The delegation, which arrived for a two-day visit on Tuesday, was led by Yukio Hayashida of the Liberal Democratic Party (LDP). Other members were from the Heiseikai, Social Democratic Party of Japan (SDP) and Japanese Communist Party (JCP).

Adam told newsmen later that the senators were impressed with the rapid development achieved by Malaysia under the able leadership of the Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

He said he told the Japanese visitors that Japan's great achievement in its industrialisation programme had always been a big inspiration to Malaysia, which was a clear proof of Malaysia's Look East Policy. --
