LANGKAWI INTERNATIONAL DIALOGUE RESPONSE OVERWHELMING

KUALA LUMPUR, July 24 (Bernama) -- The three-day second Langkawi International Dialogue beginning July 29 has received overwhelming response, chairman of the international steering group Tan Sri Tajudin Ramli said.

Over 300 participants, including three heads of governments from as far as Africa, chief executive officers and government officers would attend the dialogue, he said after Malaysian Airline System Bhd (MAS)'s 25th annual general meeting and extraordinary general meeting here today.

Tajudin, who is also chairman of MAS and the Malaysian Industry-Government Group for High Technology (MIGHT) said, participants would be able to share their experiences of doing business in the region and offer opportunities for investment that exist in their home country.

Last year's response was impressive and the end result was positive because a number of smart partnership was forged following the interactive sessions.

"I anticipate a number of memoranda to be signed at the end of the dialogue session to develop projects," Tajudin said.

He said the dialogue sessions would zoom into business and "we are completely commercial."
