MAHATHIR AND SOUTH KOREAN PRESIDENT TO HOLD TALKS

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 25 (Bernama) -- South Korean President Kim Young Sam, who arrives here tomorrow for a three-day state visit, will hold bilateral talks with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad on Wednesday.

Their meeting will be followed by one between the delegations of both countries at the Prime Minister's Department.

Upon his arrival at the Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah International Airport in Subang, Kim will be taken in a motorcade to Parliament Square for the official welcoming ceremony.

Later in the evening, Dr Mahathir and his wife Datin Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali will make a courtesy call on Kim and his wife at the Hilton Hotel.

The South Korean President and his wife will then have an audience with the Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Ja'afar and Raja Permaisuri Agong Tuanku Najihah at Istana Negara, which will be followed by a state banquet.

On Wednesday, Kim will have lunch with Dr Mahathir at Carcosa Seri Negara and this will be followed by the bilateral talks at the PM's Department.

Kim will end his visit on Thursday. -- BERNAMA
